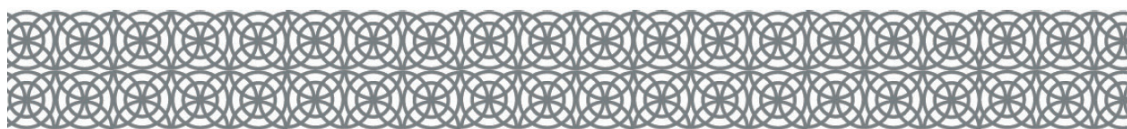

How does the Lord's Supper signify and seal to you that you share in Christ's one sacrifice on the cross and in all His gifts?

**In this way:**

**Christ has commanded me and all believers**

**to eat of this broken bread and drink of this cup in remembrance of Him.**

**With this command He gave these promises:**

**First, as surely as I see with my eyes**

**the bread of the Lord broken for me and the cup given to me,**

**so surely was His body offered for me**

**and His blood poured out for me on the cross.**

**Second, as surely as I receive from the hand of the minister**

**and taste with my mouth the bread and the cup of the Lord**

**as sure signs of Christ's body and blood,**

**so surely does He Himself nourish and refresh my soul to everlasting life**

**with His crucified body and shed blood.**
