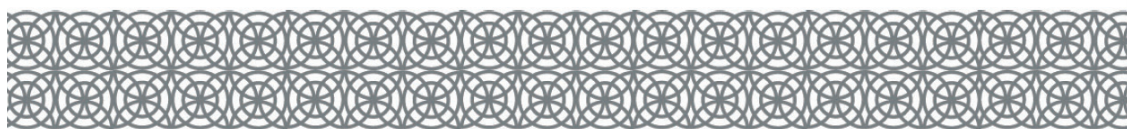

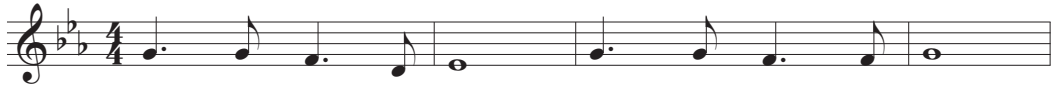

Mission to North America

James Williams has served as an ordained PCA teaching elder for over thirty years.
