Additional Scripture Readings

EXODUS 34:6 — The Lord passed before him and proclaimed, "The LORD, the LORD, a God merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast love and *faithfulness*."

PSALM 100:5 — For the LORD is good; His steadfast love endures forever, and His *faithfulness* to all generations.

1 CORINTHIANS 1:9 — God is *faithful*, by whom you were called into the fellowship of His Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.

1 CORINTHIANS 10:13 — No temptation has overtaken you that is not common to man. God is *faithful*, and He will not let you be tempted beyond your ability, but with the temptation He will also provide the way of escape, that you may be able to endure it.

1 THESSALONIANS 5:23-24 — Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely, and may your whole spirit and soul and body be kept blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. He who calls you is *faithful*; He will surely do it.

1 JOHN 1:9 — If we confess our sins, He is *faithful* and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

A Devotion from Paul David Tripp's New Morning Mercies

God has covenantally committed himself to be faithful to you forever, unleashing His wisdom, power, and grace for your eternal good. Think about this. The One who created and controls the world, the One who is the ultimate definition of what is loving, true, and good, and the One who alone has the power to finally defeat sin has chosen, because of His grace, to wrap His arms of faithful love and protection around you, and He will not let you go.

You can take your life off your shoulders because God has placed it on His. This doesn't mean that it doesn't matter how you live, but that your security is not found in your faithfulness, but in His. He can be trusted even when you cannot. He will be faithful and good even when you're not. He will do what is right and best even when you don't. And He is faithful to forgive you when convicting grace reveals how unfaithful you have been. Rather than giving you license to do whatever, this truth should give you motivation to continue. His grace calls you to invest in the one thing that will never come up short, and that one thing is the faithfulness of your Lord.

1 Corinthians 1:4-9

⁴ I give thanks to my God always for you because of the grace of God that was given you in Christ Jesus, ⁵ that in every way you were enriched in Him in all speech and all knowledge— ⁶ even as the testimony about Christ was confirmed among you— ⁷ so that you are not lacking in any gift, as you wait for the revealing of our Lord Jesus Christ, ⁸ who will sustain you to the end, guiltless in the day of our Lord Jesus Christ. ⁹ God is faithful, by whom you were called into the fellowship of His Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.
