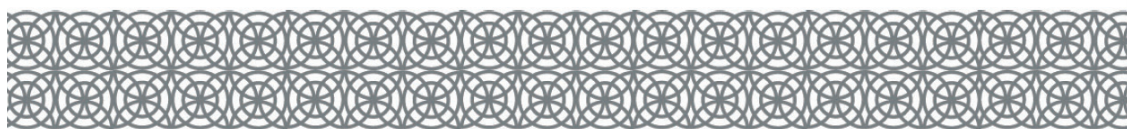

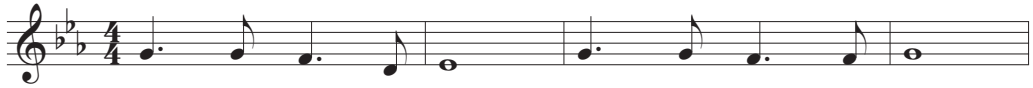
JESUS LOVES ME
