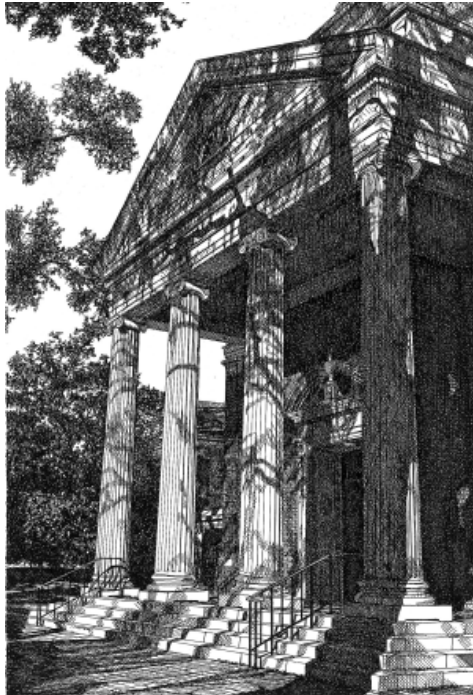

**Fathers discourage their children and crush their spirit by:**

- 4. Their own selfishness**

- 11. Hypocrisy**
