The Sacrament of the Lord's Supper is for all that are truly sorry for their sins and long to be delivered from the burden of them; all that are weary from brokenness and long to be filled with the life of Christ; all that are doubting and need the assuring embrace of God; all that humbly put their trust in Christ and desire His grace that they may lead a holy life; and all that are baptized members in an evangelical church are invited and encouraged in His name to join us in the celebration of the Lord's Supper.


