






CONCLUSION ~ Ten Reasons for Your Heart NOT to Be Troubled

1. Let NOT your heart be troubled because Jesus can be trusted.

2. Let NOT your heart be troubled because in our Father's house there are many rooms, and one of them is yours.

3. Let NOT your heart be troubled because Jesus is preparing a place for you. Repeat: the place is being prepared "FOR YOU."

4. Let NOT your heart be troubled because you know the Way to the place Jesus is preparing for you. Repeat: you know "The Way."

5. Let NOT your heart be troubled because the place is where you will be with Jesus immediately and forever.

6. Let NOT your heart be troubled because Jesus IS your dwelling place (forever). He will come and take you home.

7. Let NOT your heart be troubled because HE is the Way, the Truth, and the Life ... and you are NOT.

8. Let NOT your heart be troubled because if you have seen the Son, you have seen the Father.

9. Let NOT your heart be troubled because the Son and the Father are One.

10. Let NOT your heart be troubled because the Son sent the Spirit Who has taken up residence in your heart, and He is not only your Helper and Counselor, but He is also forever and always your Helper and Counselor.
