#614 "Now Israel May Say, And That Truly"

This hymn is based off of Psalm 124, which talks about how God protects Israel from her enemies. God promises to protect us too! Verse 8 of Psalm 124 says, "Our help is in the name of the Lord, the Maker of heaven and earth." When we call on the Lord, he will help us! Joshua 1:9 says, "Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go."

#92 "A Mighty Fortress Is Our God"

This hymn was written by Martin Luther himself, a strong leader of the Protestant Reformation. (The Protestand Reformation is the reason we celebrate Reformation Sunday and have our Reformation Party!!) The hymn was written between 1527 and 1529 and is often referred to as the "Battle Hymn of the Reformation." It is based on Psalm 46.

Did you ever think of God as being like a fortress to protect us from the attacks of Satan? He is our source of power and strength if we only call on him. Verse 2 says we must have the "right man" on our side; that is, Jesus Christ himself who "must win the battle."
