Good morning Children!

This morning, Mr. Mac will begin a series on marriage and family called "The More Excellent Way." More specifically, he will be preaching about laying a foundation of love, and our scripture will be from I Corinthians 13, which is sometimes referred to as the "Love Chapter." You often hear this passage read during wedding ceremonies.

The word "love" appears many many times in scripture. I find it interesting that I Corinthians 4 starts with the words "Love is patient, love is kind." Very often this passage is the hardest to apply to those we should love the most: our family. In his sermon, Mr. Mac will describe patience as enduring personal wrongs without retaliation (not trying to "get back" at someone because they might have done something mean to you); bearing with someone's (mom, dad, brother, sister, etc.) imperfections; and, maybe the hardest thing of all, forgiving someone over and over. Have you ever thought of forgiving someone as an act of love?

The greatest example of love is Jesus himself. He came to earth as an act of love; he forgave the people who crucified him as an act of love; and he forgives us as an act of love.

Spring break is a great time for you to put love into practice if you haven't already. Maybe you can start by asking your brother or sister, "What would you like to do today?" Or, if you have someone take a toy away from you, you could say, "It's okay, you can play with it." Try some of these things and see what happens!

I hope that you enjoy your spring break this week, and will plan to join us for some of our special services for Holy Week. 1st-6th graders, don't forget the Palm Sunday Processional at both of the morning worship services. We will line up in the Westminster Room at 8:00 am for the 8:30 service, and at 10:30 for the 11:00 am service. It would be wonderful if you could participate in both!




