

JUST A WORD FROM

Good morning boys and girls!

Today you're in for a treat. We're going to do worship a little differently today. When the younger children are dismissed to attend junior church, the 1st-6th graders are going to be dismissed to Trinity Hall so that Mr. Mac can talk to the adults.

Mr. Howell is going to talk to us about "What Kind of God is He?" He is going to discuss two important characteristics of God: a skillful builder and a powerful defender. All that we have to do is to step outside and take a look at the outdoors around us to know what a skillful builder God is! The blue sky, the fluffy white clouds, the green grass, and the beautiful flowers all point to our Father's creativity and skill! Genesis 1:2 tells us that the earth was "formless and empty" before God began to speak His creation into existence. As I'm sitting here writing this, I'm thinking about the fact that all He had to do was speak and everything (light, dark, night, day, water, sea, sky, animals, flowers, humans...EVERYTHING!) was created. That's powerful! Which leads me to my next point...

God is a powerful defender! How many of you have ever been upset with your mom or dad because they told you couldn't do something that you wanted to do really badly? I'm a mom and I want you to know that parents have to say "No" sometimes because we want to protect you. Have you been praying to God for something that you really really want but He hasn't answered that prayer? There are many reasons why God might not give us something that we want, but a lot of the time He is protecting, or defending, us from something that we're not aware of, or may not be aware of for a long time. As I reflect on some of the things that I asked God for, I can honestly tell you that it would not have been good for me if He had answered my prayer in the way that I wanted Him to. So, next time your mom or dad tells you "No," please trust them and remember that they want to protect you, and so does God! When you love someone you want to protect them.

I hope that you're working on your memory work. You have just a few more weeks to say it! The memory work and catechism deadline is May 3rd, and Promotion Sunday is May 17th.

Meet Maria & Jose

Students in the
Isaiah 55 Deaf
School
in Reynosa, Mexico

Maria and Jose are Mexican students in the Isaiah 55 School for deaf children. They are two of the four children who receive scholarships from Trinity Church so they can attend that school. Maria has been at the school for four years. Jose has been there only two years.

They cannot hear the sounds most people hear, so they cannot communicate by talking. In the school, they learn to communicate with their hands using sign language. Can you imagine not being able to talk with your parents or not being able to hear your parents say they love you? Maria is 8 years old, and Jose is 13 years old. Maria's favorite foods are eggs and potatoes and she likes art at school. Jose's favorite food is chicken. He likes computers and watching TV. In addition to sign language, they are learning to read and write and all the other things you learn at your school. They are also learning about God, and how Jesus died to save them from their sins.

You may write a letter to them, and they would like to write back to you. Will you thank God for their special school and pray for them as they continue learning?

What does that look like? Who gets to be in God's family? Let's look at Galatians 4:4-7 to find out:


"But when the fullness of time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of woman, born under the law, to redeem those who were under the law, so that we might receive adoption as sons. And because you are sons, God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, crying, "Abba! Father!" So you are no longer a slave, but a son, and if a son, then an heir through God."

This passage shows us that we are all adopted "sons" (and daughters) of God through our faith in Jesus Christ. We are not only sons, but heirs with Christ. Romans 8: 15-17 says:

"...you have received the Spirit of adoption as sons, by whom we cry, "Abba! Father!" The Spirit himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children, then heirs—heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ."

You are a member of God's family if you believe in Jesus Christ. God is your "Abba (father in Hebrew)", your Father. So, you have a father on earth and a Father in heaven. Make sure to share your love for Jesus with your earthly family and friends so they can also be a part of the family of God!
