

Dear Children,

Do you ever think much about the Holy Spirit: Who He is and what He does?

When you are reading God's Word alone or as a family or in church, and you feel a tug in your heart that you understand what is being said, THAT's the Holy Spirit teaching you.

When you feel guilty for a sin: being mean, talking rudely, making fun of someone – THAT is the Holy Spirit convicting you that you are wrong and need to confess it as sin.

If you love God, it's because of the Holy Spirit.

If you love Jesus, it's because of the Holy Spirit.

If you pray for a missionary and God answers your prayer, it's because of the Holy Spirit. If you feel the urge to tithe your allowance, it's the Holy Spirit.

If you understand why Jesus had to die on the cross, it's the Holy Spirit who taught you that.

The Holy Spirit is God. He is the third Person in the Trinity: God the Father; God the Son; and, God the Holy Spirit. He is, in fact, Jesus' Spirit.

He is our Helper.

He is our Comforter.

He is our Counselor.

He is our Teacher.

He prays for us.


He is the One Who took what Jesus did for you on the cross and saved you.



HEAD OF THE HOME - READS

Each Morning or Evening Begin "Family Time" by saying, Let us worship God in this place! If we draw near to Him, He promises to draw near to us!

HEAD OF THE HOME - PRAYS

Begin with a prayer of thanksgiving, asking God to bless your time together as a family.

Sing the Doxology

Reading God's Word

Maybe as a family you are reading through a book of the Bible or perhaps some systematic way of reading. If not, the following would bless your family as you consider the morning sermon:

Ephesians 5:15-21; Ezekiel 16:8-14; Romans 15:30; Ephesians 4:30; Romans 8:26; John 14:26; John 16:8; John 15:26; John 3:3; Ephesians 1:18-19; Acts 4:31-32

Suggested Questions from the Morning Sermon

- 1. Who is the Holy Spirit? Is the Holy Spirit God? (Yes! God the Holy Spirit.)
 - 2. In what ways does the Holy Spirit help us?
- 3. What do you personally think the most important prayer you can pray for your family would be?
 - 4. In what ways is He your Counselor or Teacher or Comforter?
- 5. What is the Holy Spirit's role in salvation? (He moves in us first; He brings us to life spiritually; He draws us to Jesus; He makes what Jesus did for us real.)
 - 6. In what ways can we point people to Jesus?
- 7. If someone's life is changed during a sermon, is that because Mr. Mac did it?

 No! The Holy Spirit did it! (Discuss.)
- 8. What does the husband's wedding ring say to him? How do we apply that to our relationship with Jesus? ("I belong to Another.")
 - 9. What are some of the results of being filled with the Holy Spirit?

Friendship Mission serving in Montgomery

Proverbs 19:17

"Whoever is generous to the poor lends to the Lord, and He will repay him for his deed."

This week's ministry is in Montgomery. Friendship Mission helps poor and homeless people by giving them a place to stay, something to eat, and an opportunity to hear preaching and teaching about Jesus. The Bible tells us in many ways that God cares for poor people and that we should, too.

The ministry has buildings in two different parts of Montgomery. One building is just for men. The other building is for single women and women who have children. Friendship Mission will let anyone stay for a few nights especially when it is very hot, cold or raining, but they will let some people stay for up to a year if those people really want to work and learn how to take care of themselves. They teach people that God expects us to work and be responsible for ourselves and our families.

They also teach people how to do certain jobs and then help them find jobs so they can earn enough money to live. At the same time they are doing these things, the Friendship Mission staff tell people about Jesus and what the Bible tells us about how we should live.

Do you have the Holy Spirit? How do you know?

"Repent and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. For the promise is for you and for your children and for all who are far off, everyone whom the Lord our God calls to himself." Acts 2:38-39

If you have asked Jesus to be your Lord and Savior and you truly believe in Him, His Holy Spirit lives inside of you! The Holy Spirit will produce fruit in your life. The kind of fruit the Holy Spirit produces is not the same kind of fruit you eat. This is a different kind of fruit that grows inside of you. The fruits of the Holy Spirit are:
