

Dear Children,

Have you ever thought about getting married one day? Some of you may have, but I bet that most of you have other things on your mind because you are still very young.

In the passage in 1 Corinthians 7 that Mr. Mac will be preaching from today, Paul says, "It is good for a man not to marry." Please understand, he is NOT saying that a man (or woman) should not marry! In fact, Paul goes on to tell married couples what their obligations are to each other; but, a little further in I Corinthians 7:17, Paul talks about keeping the life that God has called you to, and for some people, that would mean not getting married. As you read further on in chapter 7, specifically in verse 32, Paul mentions living a life that is free from concern. He points out that an unmarried man (or woman) can devote more time to the Lord's work. A married couple wants to please their spouse, and an unmarried person can devote more time to pleasing God.

Whatever the life that God has called you to, whether to be married or to remain unmarried, presents wonderful opportunities to glorify the Lord. You have many years ahead of you to learn more about God and what His plan for your life is. Keeping God at the center of your life will help you to know and appreciate what He has planned for you! I hope that you are having a wonderful summer! Remember, the summer is an excellent time to learn your memory work and catechism!



Greek Presbyterian Pastors in Athens, Greece Tim, Giotis, Alex,& George

Trinity Church sent several missions trips to Athens, Greece in the last few years. We worked and worshipped with Greek Presbyterians in the First Greek Evangelical Church and the Greek Bible College. Several of their pastors pictured below came to our church and preached here.

Trinity helps supports these Greek men who serve in their own country. They started at least five other churches in different neighborhoods of Athens. They also do ministries with children who don't go to church and immigrants from other countries who came to Greece seeking a better life. Several of the churches these pastors started minister to these immigrants who come from countries where most people don't know about Jesus or worship the Living God as we do. All the people who live in Greece are having a hard time because their banks have been closed so people can't get money to buy food or other things they need to live. The pastors asked us to pray for their church members and the people of Greece. Will you pray for them?
