

JUST A WORD FROM **Mr. Mac**

Dear Children,

We use the word love a lot, don't we?

"I love my family. I love my dog. I love pizza. I love God."

But I don't love my dog in the same way I love my family. Nor do I love pizza like I love God. So we sorta have to be careful about what we mean when we say we love something or someone. And further we should know why we love that person or that place or that thing.

"Love" is the first fruit of the spirit listed in Galatians 5:22-23. It is the most important of the nine in that the rest of the list flows out of love. Paul even says in I Corinthians 13:13, "Now abide faith, hope and love, these three; but the greatest of these is love."

- When you love someone you are willing to sacrifice for them; you are willing to be that person's servant, whether it's your mom and dad, or a little sister or brother... but especially God.
- When you love someone, it means you do the right thing toward that person. Your mom and dad love you, and one of the ways you know they love you is they punish you when you disobey. If they did not love you, they would not punish you.
- When you love someone, you have a feeling toward them that is loving.
- When you become a Christian, God changes your heart, He makes you a new creation. You know why? He loves you. And because you are thankful to Him you respond with love for Him.

Missionary Kids

Did you ever wonder what it was like to be a child in a missionary family? The Johnsons are members of Trinity Church, and are normally here with us each week, but on May 30th they left to spend the summer in Sweden. Gary and Linda are the mom and dad. Linda was born and raised in Sweden. Gary was born and raised in Mississippi. He is a Presbyterian minister who started two churches in Sweden.

They have lived in Montgomery for the last four years, but most of the older children in their family were born in Sweden. They have citizenship in Sweden and the United States. They speak Swedish and to some degree even consider that country their home country.

They are spending this summer in Sweden renewing friendships with the people they knew from when they lived there. The four oldest boys will play baseball with Swedish teams.
