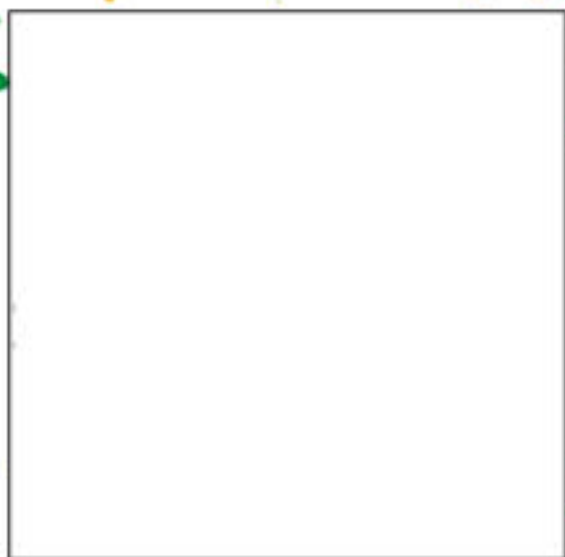

The Welshes are members of Trinity Church, but they live in Hungary where they were called to serve as missionaries fourteen years ago. David was the assistant headmaster at Trinity Presbyterian School when they lived here. Now he is the Director at the International Christian School of Budapest. This school has about 250 students including many missionary children, Hungarian children and other international students from around the world who live in Budapest. Jennifer also teaches at the school.

David and Jennifer have three children – Tait, Connor and Hamilton. When they left Montgomery, Tait was in kindergarten. Now she is a student at Samford University in Birmingham while Conner and Hamilton remain in Hungary to finish high school.

#252 "When I Survey the Wondrous Cross"

Do you ever stop to take a real close look at the cross and what it meant for Jesus to have to die on that terrible instrument of torture for your very own sins? Many people don't like to think about the price Christ had to pay because those thoughts are just too painful. We might not be murderers or thieves, but we all have pride in our hearts. "Sorrow and love flow mingled down" means that as he was dying for us, he had the mixed emotions of love and sorrow at the same time. In the 4th verse, we see where Isaac Watts, the hymn writer, concludes that "love so amazing and divine demands our soul, our life, OUR ALL!"

#32 "Great is Thy Faithfulness"

Our God is faithful! To be faithful means to be loyal, devoted, and unswerving. God is ALWAYS faithful to us. 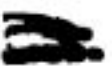
