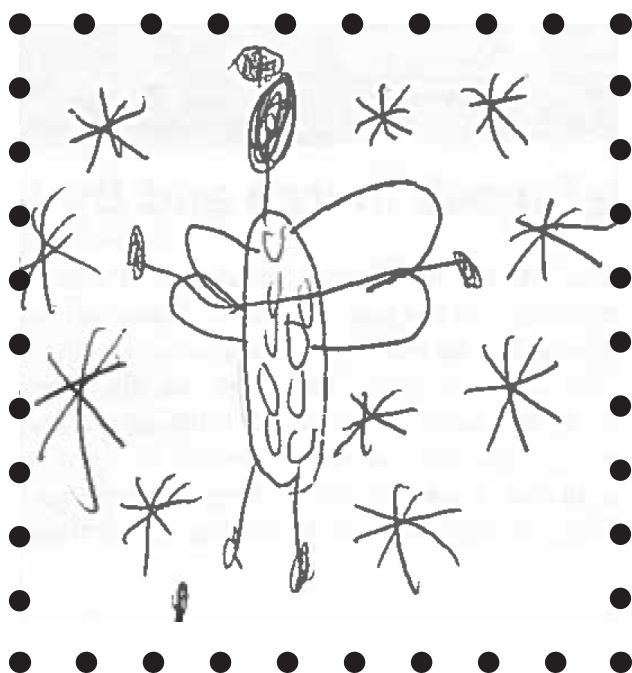

JUST A WORD FROM Mr. Curles

Dear Children,

The great blue heron is a large bird standing almost four feet tall and having a wing span of six feet. One amazing thing about the heron is its patience. It stands, perfectly still, in a pond or lake for long periods of time, waiting for a fish to swim by. It may be windy. It may be raining or even snowing, but the heron, although it appears to be uncomfortable, continues fishing, waiting to catch his dinner.

The fruit of the Spirit that we are learning about today is patience. Patience means that we let God do His work in other people and the world the way He wants, when He wants, and how He wants. We let God be God and we don't insist on having things right away. The Bible also calls this waiting on God. And God wants us to wait for Him to act, because even if we got things to happen just the way we want, they will never be as good as if God does it. His way is always the best.

How do we get patience? Well, one way is to remember how God is patient with us. He is patient while we learn, while we forget to do what we are supposed to do, while we sometimes take a long time to understand what He is trying to teach us. He is so patient with us! When we remember that it helps us practice the same patience toward others.

What are some ways God is calling you to be patient? Ask Him to give you the fruit of patience, like Jesus, through the power of the Holy Spirit.

In all things, we have hope because we are "...the children of God..." (8:19). So when you pray, be patient. Pray, be patient, and trust that God loves you and will help you.

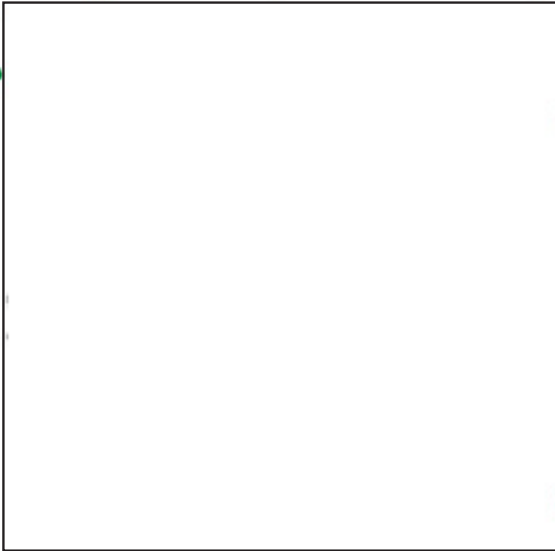

Becky was born in Charlotte, North Carolina, but raised in Taiwan because her father was a minister and her family became missionaries in Taiwan. She went to Covenant College in Tennessee but then returned to Taiwan after learning to be an English teacher. She works at Christ's College where she teaches English literature and writing to Chinese students from Taiwan and mainland China. She has been teaching there for over twenty-five years. Becky enjoys working at Christ's College because she loves teaching literature and communication from a Christian perspective. It also allows her to build close relationships with students so she can share the gospel with them through counseling and prayer. Her college was started in Taiwan to strengthen the church in that country through educating, evangelizing and discipling Chinese students. Some of her students who graduated became teachers and now they do the same thing she does to help others know Jesus. One of the graduates of that college attends Trinity Church now.

#600 "He Leadeth Me: O Blessed Thought!"

Psalm 73:23-24 says "You hold me by my right hand. You guide me with your counsel." Your heavenly Father leads you by the hand just as your earthly father or mother did when you were a small child.
