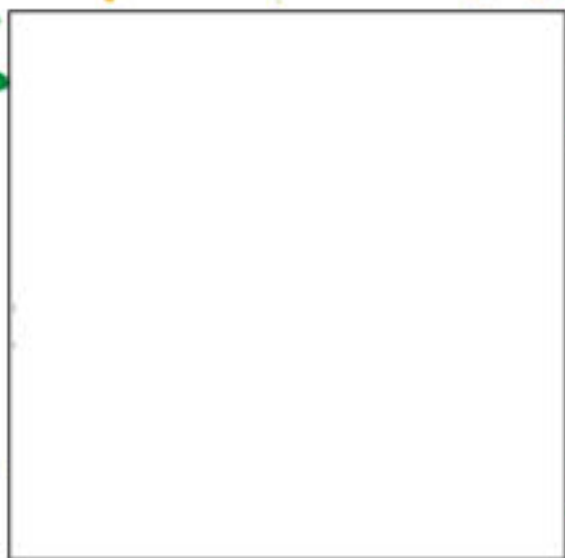

This week we will think about some children whose parents are missionaries. They are Adelaide, Schaeffer, Leo and Alexander. They are Trinity Church members who live in Cambridge, England with their parents who are missionaries there.

Adelaide is in the third grade. Schaeffer is in the first grade. The public schools don't ever talk about God there so they walk to a Christian school that is about five blocks away from their house. Their school year is almost over for the summer, but they have longer vacations during the year. They also attend Cambridge Presbyterian Church. It is much smaller than Trinity Church with about 100 people in the worship service each Sunday. Adelaide and Schaeffer like to read but they also play with many of the same toys you play with.

A missions team from Trinity visited them recently. The team took Tootsie Roll Pops and other treats because they can't buy those in England.
