

She had etched in the stone in her prison cell the word "Resist."

I pray for you that you would be faithful: faithful to God and faithful to others. Believe what God says is true and obey Him. Be true to your word and what is expected of you and you will be a faithful person.

Meet Faith Radio Serving Montgomery and Central & South Alabama

This week's ministry is Faith Radio in Montgomery and six other locations in Alabama. Perhaps you have heard your parents listening to it or maybe you listen to Paws & Tales and Adventures in Odyssey that are on at 8:30 and 9:00 on Saturday mornings. Many of the programs include ministers and Bible teachers and Christian music. All of their programs are planned to encourage Christians and help others who don't know Jesus learn about Him.

Faith Radio is a "listener supported" station, which means they depend on donations from people who listen to the station instead of selling advertising like most stations do. The station broadcasts at 89.1 FM in Montgomery. Their call letters are WLBF, which stands for "We Live By Faith." Mr. Wiely Bowsell from Trinity Church is the Chief Engineer. He keeps all the electronic components functioning so the radio programs can be broadcast. Mr. John Albritton, Jr. is on the Board of Directors, which oversees all of the station activities.
