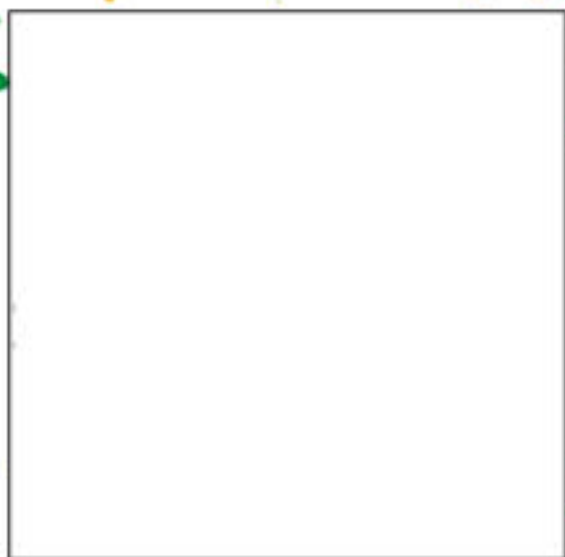

At first, Greg and Julieann, and their two sons lived in Siberia where the snow is deep and the winters are long and very cold. Then, they lived in China and then further south in warm, tropical parts of Asia. Over the years, Greg's job changed from just their family's work to now when he supervises the work of many other people that live across the entire Asian region from very cold Siberia to very warm South Asia. Greg travels much of the time to supervise the work of these other people and recruit new workers. Both of their sons are in college, so their home is in Florida now even though Greg is not there very much. Julieann also travels with him some of the time.

Many of the countries where they work do not permit missionaries to enter. Greg helps people start businesses and schools that will permit his very talented workers to use their God-given abilities to help people earn an income while they also share about God's love and His desire for people from every tribe, language and nation to worship Him.

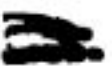
