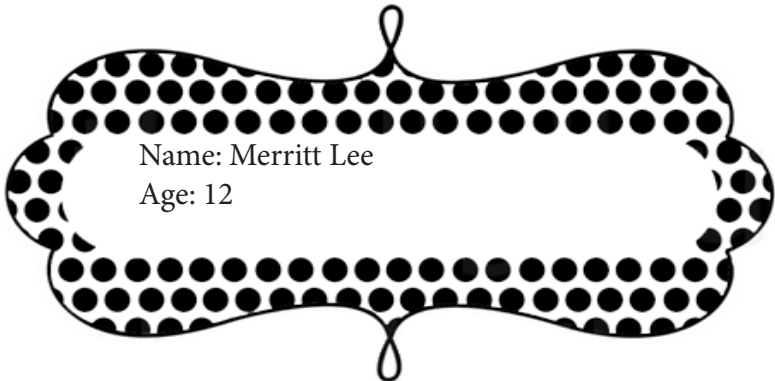

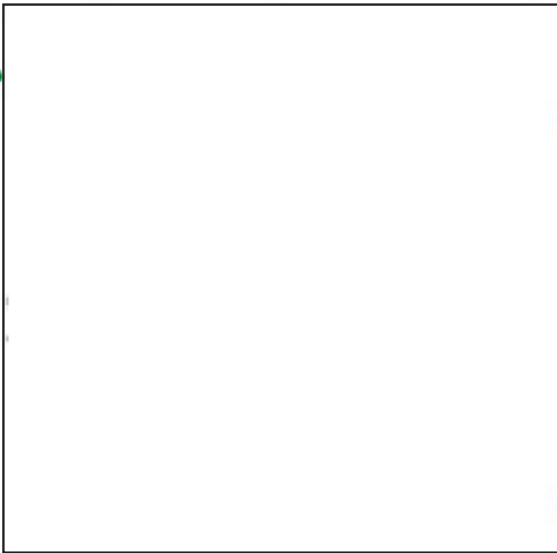

GREEK PRESBYTERIAN PASTORS IN ATHENS

Trinity Church sent several missions trips to Athens, Greece in the last few years. We worked and worshipped with Greek Presbyterians in the First Greek Evangelical Church and the Greek Bible College. Several of their pastors pictured below came to our church and preached here.

Trinity helps supports these men who serve in their own country. Beginning with one church in the middle of the city, they started other churches in different neighborhoods of Athens. They also lead ministries with children who don't go to church and immigrants from other countries who came to Greece seeking a better life. Those immigrants come from countries where most people don't know about Jesus or worship the Living God as we do. All the people who live in Greece are having a hard time because their economy has made everything very expensive to buy. The pastors asked us to pray for their church members and the people of Greece to know the Bible and follow Jesus. Will you pray for them?

MUSIC and Hymns



#100 “Holy, Holy, Holy!”

This hymn speaks of a time when ALL of God’s creatures “in earth and sky and sea” will praise His name. Even the “Cherubim and Seraphim,” the angels, will bow and worship Him in heaven. All men, angels, animals, and living things will praise God. Isn’t it going to be wonderful?!

#693 “Blessed Assurance”

This hymn was written in 1873 by Fannie J. Crosby. The lyrics are based on Hebrews 10:22-23, which says “let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, with our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water. Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful.” Fannie was a blind hymn writer who wrote over 8,000 hymns in her lifetime. This hymn was especially special to her, as the words of the first verse are even engraved on her tombstone.
