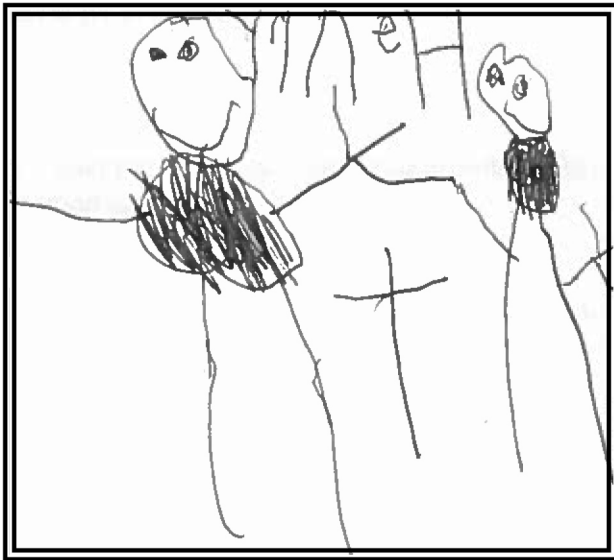


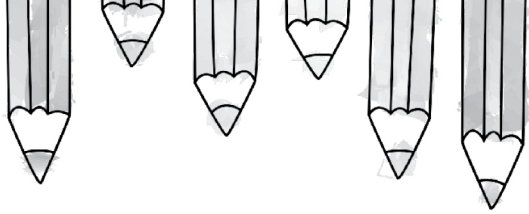

Some are words that you have not learned yet. Some of them are hard even for your mom and dad and me to understand. That's why this morning, I'll be going through them and trying to explain them.

I am going to give you five easier ones, and you write out in your own words what you think they mean (even before I tell you in my sermon):

1. Evil
2. Murder
3. Gossip
4. Boastful
5. Foolish

Even those seem a little difficult. Listen this morning as I go through them.

But please understand this: we all sin. Everyone has sinned. Jesus came to save us from those sins. Jesus came to die to take away all 21 of those sins!!! And every other sin you and I have ever committed!!

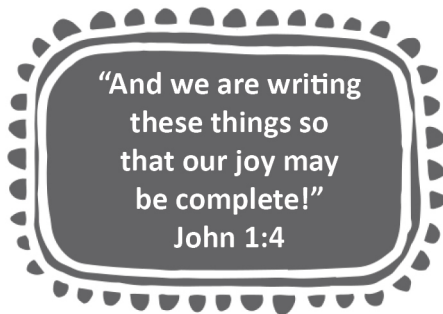
He is so good. He is so loving. He loves YOU. You can trust Him!

We sometimes hear lists of sins like this today, and we pray: God, forgive me for these and all my many sins. 

Meet Our Missionaries!



**Birmingham
Theological Seminary
serving Alabama
and other places
around the world.**

This week's ministry is Birmingham Theological Seminary. A seminary is a school where men study to become pastors. Birmingham Seminary was started in 1972 by two pastors who saw the need for a school to train more pastors and teachers. While some men spend three or four years going to a seminary after they complete four years of college, other people begin working as a business person, or teacher or engineer, and then they realize that God is calling them to become a minister, Bible teacher or counselor. Birmingham Seminary is for those people who are doing one job, but want to take classes in the evenings to serve God in a different way. Classes are offered in other cities across Alabama including Montgomery, and more classes are taught online for people who live outside of Alabama and even outside the United States. Trinity member, Dr. Harrison Taylor teaches a class on church history. Trinity members Brent Woodall and Houstoun Waring are taking classes from this seminary.

Romans 3:23-26
