







#55 "To God Be the Glory"


This hymn reminds us of what Jesus has done for us. He "yielded His life an atonement for sin, and opened the lifegate that we may go in." Jesus gave His life for us so that we may be forgiven of our sins and live in Heaven with Him for all eternity. Did you know that Jesus doesn't just save good people? He will also save those who have done terrible things if they believe in Him. Verse 2 says "the vilest offender who truly believes, that moment from Jesus forgiveness receives."

#498 "Jesus! What a Friend for Sinners!"

Jesus is the perfect friend! He is always there to listen when you need someone to talk to, He loves you no matter what, He doesn't judge you or think less of you, and He is always willing to help! Your Inheritance

Did you know that if you are a believer in Christ Jesus you are a "coheir" with Christ? That is so hard to imagine. Not only did Jesus die for you, but He also wants you to be a coheir with Him. Isn't that AMAZING! You, my friend, are a son or daughter of the King of Kings and the Lord of Lords! An heir is someone who inherits something from someone. So, if your grandparents were to pass away and leave something to you, that would be considered something you inherited from them. You also inherit genes and DNA from your family. Your eye color or hair color may be inherited as well. The Bible says that when we become a follower of Jesus Christ we become part of the blood line of Christ. So, although we inherited DNA from our families, we are now a part of the family of Christ and we share in His inheritance. You are now "Abraham's offspring." In Matthew chapter 1, Jesus is referred to as "Jesus Christ, the son of David, the son of Abraham." If you are a believer, you are a son or daughter of Abraham too. What are we inheriting? Eternal life with Christ!

Romans 4:13

For the promise to Abraham and his offspring that he would be heir of the world did not come through the law but through the righteousness of faith.

Colossians 1:11-14

May you be strengthened with all power, according to His glorious might, for all endurance and patience with joy; giving thanks to the Father, who has qualified you to share in the **inheritance** of the saints in light. He has delivered us from the domain of darkness and transferred us to the kingdom of his beloved Son, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.

Romans 8:14-18

All those led by God's Spirit are God's sons. For you did not receive a spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption, by whom we cry out, "Abba, Father!" The Spirit Himself testifies together with our spirit that we are God's children, and if children, also heirs—heirs of God and coheirs with Christ—seeing that we suffer with Him so that we may also be glorified with Him.

Galatians 3:29

And if you are Christ's, then you are Abraham's offspring, heirs according to promise.

Ephesians 3:6

This mystery is that the Gentiles are fellow heirs, members of the same body, and partakers of the promise in Christ Jesus through the gospel.

James 2:5

Listen, my beloved brothers, has not God chosen those who are poor in the world to be rich in faith and heirs of the kingdom, which he has promised to those who love him?

Titus 3:4-7

But when the goodness and loving kindness of God our Savior appeared, he saved us, not because of works done by us in righteousness, but according to His own mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewal of the Holy Spirit, whom he poured out on us richly through Jesus Christ our Savior, so that being justified by His grace we might become heirs according to the hope of eternal life.
