# Learning Together!

## THE GREAT COMMISSION

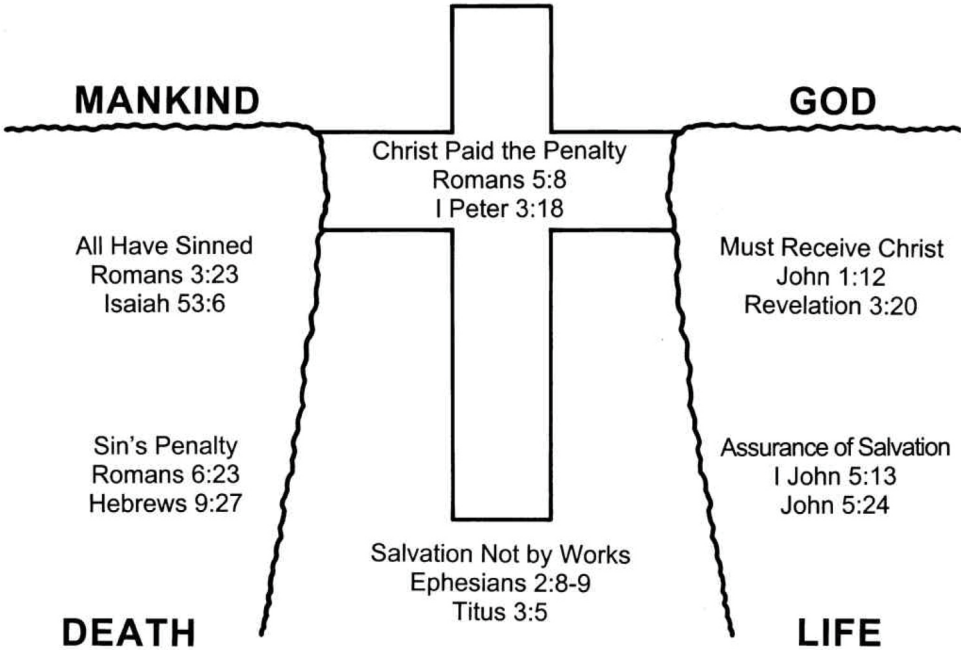
Do you know what the **Great Commission** is? This is where Jesus told His disciples to go and make more disciples! Jesus said “Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you.”

How do you make new disciples? You share the Good News of Jesus Christ! You can ask someone “do you know Jesus?” If they say “no,” you can tell them about how much Jesus loves them, how we are all separated from God by sin and how Jesus died on the cross for their sins and is now the bridge between us and God that allows us to have peace with God. If they want to know more, offer to give them a Bible to read and invite them to church. Let them know that you will be there to answer any questions they might have about your faith and why you believe.

One of the best ways to make a disciple is to live out your faith in front of others. Always think about being a representative of Christ wherever you go. When others see how you treat people and how you handle certain situations, they will gravitate toward you. A Christian should be loving and forgiving. We should also be willing to admit that we are wrong and that all people make mistakes.

So, be a friend to someone, share the love of Christ with others, and make disciples. You don’t have to go around the world to do it. You can do it right here in Montgomery, Alabama at your school and in your neighborhood. Be prepared that some people will not want to hear the Good News and they might not be very nice about it. That is ok. Just simply move on to the next person and pray for that other person’s heart to open up. You may have planted a seed just by simply telling them, even if they do not accept it at first.

If you have a paper and pencil handy, it is always helpful to use the bridge illustration to share the Gospel.



Memorize this illustration and these scriptures and practice explaining this to someone. This way you will always be prepared to share the gospel with someone. Can you think of any other ways you can share the gospel?
