


It doesn't have to be football. What about TV? What about video games? What about even eating? How much time do you spend enjoying that God-given gift ... eating a delicious meal?

All to say, God has done something absolutely wonderful for you! He has saved you from your sin! He has forgiven you for everything you ever did or ever will do wrong. He has loved you. He has shown you so much grace and mercy and compassion.


What I am asking is this: how much time do you give God?

Opening Scriptures to Be Used to Open Family Time Isaiah 40:28-31

[Read every day. Would it possible to memorize this passage as a family?]

Opening Prayer

Head of Home, why don't you ask mom to open in prayer each day this week? If you are single parent, proceed as usual and/or ask the children to open in prayer.

Read the Word

Read Romans 6:11-14
Read it in the ESV, then read it in *The Message*

Tell the Story

Mr. Mac told a funny story about the psychologist who told his client to just "stop it." And she kept telling her about all her fears and problems, and he would just tell her to, "stop it." (Bob Newhart clip on YouTube) Talk about how Romans 6 seems to be simply telling us to "stop it" with no reason given as to why or how. YES, God does want us to stop our sinning, but why and how? *Discuss*.

Discussion Time

Take the detailed outline and read through "THE BATTLEFIELD OF THE BELIEVER." Try to explain this to your children in your own words.



Meet Our Missionaries!



Bee Serving with Ambassadors for Christ, International in South Asia

Bee was raised in Thailand, but has worked for over 15 years doing Bible translation, evangelism and discipleship among the several tribal people groups of the remote parts of another South Asian country. She trains Christians to lead Bible studies and then start new house churches. Much of this resulted from discipling young people in scripture and Bible story telling techniques. Now some of these new church plants are already starting to reproduce by planting new groups in their neighboring villages.

In early 2013, a prison ministry began with remarkable results. Many prisoners came to faith in Jesus and 16 Bible study groups were formed. Over 60 prisoners learned to read the Bible. The prisoners even learned to grow enough vegetables to feed themselves a much better diet so they were physically and spiritually healthy. Some of those former prisoners who completed their sentence and were released from jail are now pastoring churches.


The Lord's mercies are new every single morning.

How much do you think God loves you? _	

John 3:16 is probably the most famous Bible verse about God's love:

For God so loved the world, that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life.

Ephesians 2:4-5

But God, being rich in mercy, because of the great love with which He loved us, even when we were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ—by grace you have been saved –

God loves you and His love is a free gift, but God also wants us to love others.

A New Commandment

John 13:34-35
