


When I was growing up, we had a really bad flood in Jackson, MS. The flood was in 1979. There was actually another one, but it was not as bad as 1979. My school was under water. We were out of school for three weeks. We rode around in boats trying to help people; we put sandbags around people's houses trying to keep the water out; I was even part of a crew that went into a doctor's office in a boat trying to save his equipment.

That's what Jesus has done for us: rescued us!

From what has He rescued us? Our sin. Eternal punishment (hell).



- What is Paul's simple illustration about our union with Christ? (7:2-3) Marriage
- Mom and Dad, this illustration and then subsequent line of reasoning is very complex for adults, much less children. Perhaps you could emphasize the following: we are married to Jesus He loves us so! we should WANT to please Him just like a wife wants to please her husband.

- What about using the illustration Mr. Mac used about those in prison seeing those on the outside driving by or riding by on a train ~ sure, they have their own set of problems, but they are not in prison; they are free!! We are free from the law; not imprisoned by the law. Our train stays on the track; we obey the rules of the road; but, we do so with freedom and out of respect.



Good News Club at Forest Avenue Elementary Magnet Sponsored by Trinity Church And Child Evangelism Fellowship

Child Evangelism Fellowship (CEF) is a worldwide organization dedicated to seeing every child reached with the Gospel of the Lord Jesus, and then discipled and established in a local church.

One of their best-known ministries is called Good News Club. These clubs meet in public schools after regular classes. Twenty of these clubs are in Central Alabama. Trinity Church sponsors a Club at Forest Avenue Elementary Magnet School. Each week the volunteers from Trinity Church present an exciting Bible lesson, songs, Scripture memory, a missions story and fun games. The Club is like Sunday School except that it is on Tuesday afternoon.

Music and Hymns


#247 "O Sacred Head, Now Wounded"

This hymn praises and thanks Jesus Christ for dying on the cross for our sins. The author of this hymn declares: "Tis I deserve Thy place." Jesus stood in our place. He took the punishment for our sins and He paid the full price for our freedom. Let this be your prayer: "Lord, let me never, never outlive my love to Thee." How can we ever thank Him for such a sacrifice? The hymn writer asks, "what language shall I borrow to thank Thee, dearest Friend?" Can you think of some ways you can thank Jesus for dying for you?

"The Power of the Cross"

Do you know the power of the cross? Without the cross, you and I would still be cursed by the law. Without the cross, there would be no salvation. Jesus died on the cross for our sins. He did it before you were ever born and before you ever had the chance to sin because He loves you and He chose to die for you. Verse 4 says "Oh, to see my name written in the wounds..." Isaiah 49:16 says "Behold, I have engraved you on the palms of my hands." Isn't that amazing! Praise God for His son dying on the cross for your sins!
