## Serving in <br> Europe with Serge

Harold began working in Europe about 18 years ago. After he married Sarah, they joined a church planting team among Indians and Pakistanis (Hindus, Sikhs and Muslims). They were drawn to do more Muslim evangelism and church planting. Several years ago, they accepted a new position with a different church planting work among Muslims in another city and work with a church that wants to tell Muslims about Jesus.

Their ministry is very sensitive because some Muslims are hostile to Jesus, but many more Muslims are disappointed with Islam and want to hear about Jesus. They make many friends and look for people who are open to talking about Jesus. Elizabeth is just a baby, but Thomas is 12 , Nathanael is 10 and Owen is 6 . All three boys help with the ministry of friendship, but they really depend on prayer and the Holy Spirit to change people's hearts.
