



#### Just a word from Mr. Mac

Dear Children,

This morning at 8:30 we will be baptizing Campbell Cooper's little brother, Grayson.

What does that mean that we are baptizing a baby? Can you think of five things you have seen in worship when Mr. Mac baptizes babies? I'll help you get started:

But what IS baptism?

Baptism is a sacrament given to us by Jesus Himself. He gave us baptism (and the Lord's Supper or Communion) to show the world who we are, to set us apart from the world, as well as to comfort and strengthen us.

We are looking at God's promises to be our God, and He graciously gave us a sign of that covenant/promise/pledge: the washing with water. The washing of the water points to our being washed and cleansed by the blood of Jesus.

Notice this morning, when Mr. Cooper baptizes his son, Grayson, that he will baptize him in the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Ghost.


We baptize believers  $^{\sim}$  people who have made it known that they are trusting in Jesus Christ alone for their salvation; who have repented of their sins; and who promise that they will live like people who follow Jesus.

We also baptize the children of believers. We do this because we believe God has always given the sign of His covenant with His people to their children. He included them in His covenant. We believe that the covenant that God made with Abraham is still in effect.

Jesus loves children!! He loves you! And when (if) you were baptized, it really did bind you to be a true follower of Jesus Christ. And the Church is here to help you do that.



# Mary Fran Morris Serving with Mission to the World Medical In El Calvador

Mary Fran was raised in Montgomery and attended Trinity Church with her family since she was a baby. She has known and loved Jesus for as long as she can remember. Several people in her extended family were doctors or nurses, but she became interested in nursing because one of her brothers was very sick and had many special medical needs.

She studied nursing at college and became a pediatric nurse because she loves children and wants to bring healing to them. She works at Children's Healthcare in Atlanta, and also travels on medical missions trips to other countries that don't have good health care. She liked medical trips so much that she felt God was calling her to lead trips. This week she is co-leading a medical missions trip to El Salvador. It is a very poor country and many people are not able to see doctors when they are sick. Her team has several doctors, a dentist, a pharmacist, several nurses and other non-medical people who talk with and encourage the patients to know and trust Jesus.


# Music and Hymns
