

Evelin Olmedo & Maria Trevino Students in the Isaiah 55 Deaf School In Reynosa, Mexico

Evelin and Maria are students at the Isaiah 55 School for deaf children in Reynosa, Mexico. They receive a scholarship from Trinity Church so they can attend that school. It was started by NoNo and Kate Beale who are Trinity members and missionaries in Mexico.

Deaf children cannot hear the sounds most people hear, so they cannot communicate by talking. In their school, they learn sign language with their hands. Can you imagine not being able to talk with your parents or not being able to hear your parents say they love you? In addition to sign language, they learn to read and write and all the other things you learn at your school. They also learn about God, how Jesus died and was brought to life again to save them from their sins, and bring them into a new life for God.

Evelin is twelve and Maria is eleven years old. They are in the sixth grade. Evelin's father works in a factory. Her favorite foods are potatoes, grapes, broccoli and apples. Maria's father drives a car for a wealthy person. Her favorite food is pizza. Will you write a letter to them? They would like to write back to you. 
