




Listen this morning and see if you hear me name a few. I would love to see your list.



Sedrick Fluker, Fred Tisdale, and Shametria Bush of Montgomery STEP Foundation

Trinity and several other churches started STEP Foundation in Montgomery nearly 30 years. The goal was and still is to help people know about Jesus. There are many people in our own city who never go to church or ever get to hear the truth about God.

STEP stands for Strategies To Elevate People. A strategy is a plan or a way to do something. Elevate means to lift up something. The best way to lift up a person's life is to help them know God, and how He sent His son Jesus to die for their sins and give them a new life. Some of the people in Montgomery who don't know about Jesus are students who live in poor neighborhoods. Some of them face failure in school and many problems that make them very angry.

STEP provides special counselors in several public schools where low-income children attend. Sedrick, Fred and Shametria help students learn to not be angry about the sad things in their lives and to control their anger by putting their faith in Jesus. These counselors also organize choirs and after school recreation, and they plan fun summer time activities for the children.

Let every heart prepare Him room!


#213 "What Child Is This?"
