



But He didn't look at any of that. He loved you because He loved you.



THE SIMPLEST OUTLINE FOR FAMILY TIME EVER! 10 EASY STEPS

#1 Just make sure you gather once a day as a family. Try really hard to make the same time every day. #2 It does not have to be long; it does not have to be perfect. #3 Read a Bible verse. Maybe a devotional. #4 Sing a song or two together. #5 #6 Take prayer requests. Pray. (Daddy, your children NEED to hear you pray.) Everyone tell one thing they are thankful for. #8 Have a Leader of the Day: they get to read and/or pray and/ #9 or tell everyone to come gather and/or put out the Bibles/ hymnals and/or tell something that happened to them that day. #10 Dad, pray this over your children: Numbers 6:24-26 The LORD bless you and keep you; the LORD make His face to shine upon you and be gracious to you; the LORD lift up His countenance upon you and give you peace.



Meet Our Missionaries!



The Waring Family Houstoun & Tami, Muriel, Virginia, Isobel and Richard Serving Maxwell Air Force Base

Houstoun and Tami Waring live in Montgomery, attend Trinity Church and serve as missionaries to officers at Maxwell Air Force Base. Both of them attended the Air Force Academy, served as officers and were part of Officers' Christian Fellowship (OCF) which is a ministry that disciples other military people and families to follow Jesus. After they were married, Tami served on active duty until they started having children, but they continued being part of OCF throughout Houstoun's career as a fighter pilot. He served in the Air Force for over 25 years and was promoted to colonel. When he retired from active duty, they move to Montgomery and now serve full time with OCF.

Their whole family is part of this ministry. They host other families for meals, Bible studies and fellowship. They chose to serve in Montgomery because Maxwell AFB has schools that officers from across the country attend to learn how to be better officers. While those officers learn to do that, it is also a good time for them to learn to glorify God by doing their jobs well and by telling others about Jesus.
