



How wonderful to know that God can do whatever He pleases, and He has chosen to love you and me. HE decided to show you and me mercy, and He did not have to. He did because He loves us.

# THE SIMPLEST OUTLINE FOR FAMILY TIME EVER!!! 10 EASY STEPS

#1 Just make sure you gather once a day as a family. Try really hard to make the same time every day. #2 It does not have to be long; it does not have to be perfect. #3 Read a Bible verse. Maybe a devotional. #4 Sing a song or two together. #5 #6 Take prayer requests. Pray. (Daddy, your children NEED to hear you pray.) Pray #7 for the children; pray for missionaries; pray for Trinity Church; give thanks. Everyone tell one thing they are thankful for. #8 Have a Leader of the Day: they get to read and/or pray and/ #9 or tell everyone to come gather and/or put out the Bibles/ hymnals and/or tell something that happened to them that day. #10 Dad, pray this over your children: Numbers 6:24-26 The LORD bless you and keep you; the LORD make His face to shine upon you and be gracious to you; the LORD lift up His countenance upon you and give you peace.



# Meet Our Missionaries!



## Christians in China

China has more people than any other country in the world with almost one and half billion people. Over one million of those people in China are Christians, but the government does not want citizens there to be Christians so they make it very hard for people to worship God.

Some churches there have buildings like Trinity Church, but many of those are controlled by the government so they don't teach from the Bible like Mr. Mac does at Trinity. Many more Chinese Christians gather secretly in their houses and apartments so they can teach from the Bible and worship God according to the way the Bible tells us.

Recently, the Chinese government destroyed some of the churches where people are faithful to God and they even arrested pastors and other Christians in house churches. Jesus told his disciples they would be persecuted because persecutors do not know God, but He also said Christians should not worry because the Holy Spirit will help them say and do the right thing when they are arrested. The Bible tells us to remember persecuted Christians as if we were suffering with them, and it tells us to pray for them.

Will you pray for Christians in China who suffer because they are Christians?

#### #457 "Come Thou Fount of Every Blessing"

This hymn talks about the way all believers stray from God at times in their life and how God is faithful to draw us back to Him. His mercy never ceases and He continues to invite us back into His arms when we wander away from Him. In fact, Jesus pursued us when we were yet sinners. Verse 2 says "Jesus sought me when a stranger, wand'ring from the fold of God: He, to rescue me from danger, interposed His precious blood." To interpose means to come between. Jesus has come between you and your sin by cleansing you through the blood He shed on the cross. Isn't that amazing? We did nothing to deserve it and even though we may try, we continue to do wrong, yet He continues to love us! What a wondrous blessing!

#### #688 "Have Thine Own Way, Lord!"

Do you ask God to have His way in your life? What is His way is not the way You think your life should be? Isaiah 55:8 says "For My thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways My ways, declares the LORD."
