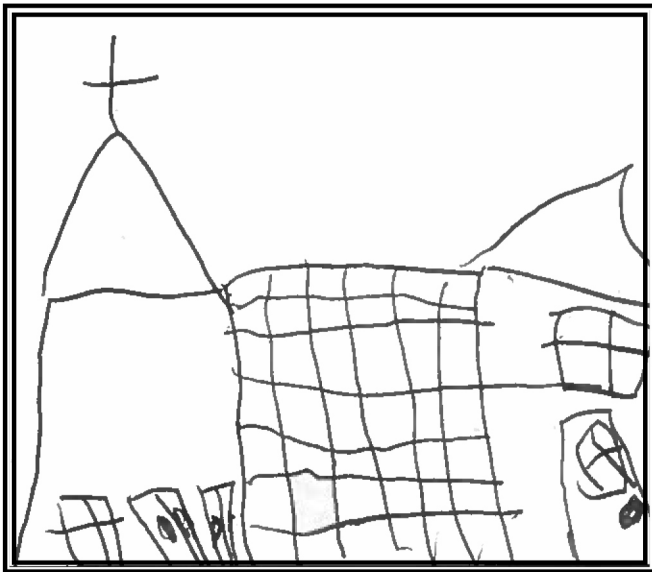

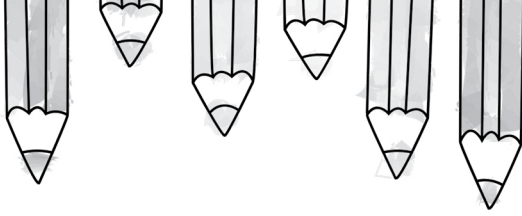

Just a word from Mr. Mac

Dear Children,

This morning, and then again tonight, we will sing some hymns of Fanny Crosby. Miss Fanny lived from 1820-1915. Her birthday is March 24.

Fanny was blinded when she was six weeks old. A doctor made a mistake, and he blinded her. But it did not make her a sad or bitter woman; rather, she was a missionary, a poet, and a hymn writer. Do you know how many hymns she wrote? 8000!!!!

The themes of her hymns are almost always joy and love and Jesus and heaven. She was a remarkable woman who could hear a piece of music, and then she would write a hymn to fit the music – she felt God was laying the words on her heart by what that tune said to her personally.

She believed she was saved by Jesus alone – not herself; not her works; nothing good in her ... only the mercy and grace of God and the blood of His dear Son, Jesus.

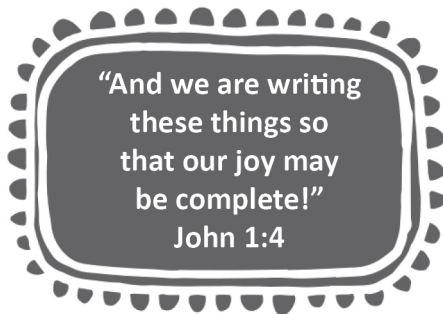
Do you believe that? Are you trusting in Jesus as your Savior from sin? And can you say you are trusting in Him alone ... NOT your works or good deeds?

Here are some things from my sermon about which you can talk to your mom and dad:

1. What are some Fanny Crosby Hymns you know? Hymns we sing at Trinity? Read some of those hymns out loud as a family, and listen to this woman who was blind and had every reason to be bitter, but she was not.
2. If someone offered you Jesus in one hand, and then offered you everything you THINK will get you to heaven in the other hand, which hand would you pick?
3. In what ways can people who go to church be deceived into thinking they are Christians when they are not? (Little bit harder: why do religious people miss the gospel so easily? Talk to your mom and dad about that.)
4. Discuss this paraphrase of Romans 9:32 ~ *How could they miss it? Because instead of trusting God, they took over. They were absorbed in what they themselves were doing. They were so absorbed in their “God projects” that they didn’t notice God right in front of them, like a huge rock in the middle of the road. And so they stumbled into him and went sprawling.*

10 EASY STEPS

- #10** Dad, pray this over your children: Numbers 6:24–26
The LORD bless you and keep you; the LORD make His face to shine upon you and be gracious to you; the LORD lift up His countenance upon you and give you peace.



#38 "Immortal, Invisible, God Only Wise"

As long as we are on the earth, God will be invisible to us. We cannot see Him, as He is hidden from our eyes, but He is visible to us in other ways. In what things, places, or people on earth do you see God? List the ways we can see Him here on earth even though we cannot physically see Him:

#264 "Jesus, Keep Me Near the Cross"

Ask Jesus to keep you near the cross. When you are near the cross, you can see beyond what is in front of you to the mercy and healing that is found in Christ. If you keep the cross in the forefront of your mind, you will not focus so much on the negative things in your life. When you lay your cares at the foot of the cross, you can let them go and trust that Jesus will take care of them! So, stay near to the cross. Stay near to the one Who died for you, Who chose you, and Who loves you!
