


Just a word from Mr. Mac

Dear Children,

Once again in Romans we see Paul's heart for the lost. Not like being lost in the woods or in a neighborhood or some unknown place; but people who are spiritually lost – people who do not know Jesus and not trusting Him for forgiveness and salvation.

I can remember times in my life when I was lost: once on a trail when my son and I were hiking, and that was scary. Once when I was about your age, and a man helped me find my mother. But that was scary too.

It's scary to be lost. But when people are spiritually lost, that's the most frightening thing there is!! It's like they need a light on their dark path. It's like they need someone to come rescue them. And YOU can do that!! You can pray for them. You can talk to people about Jesus in hopes that they find Him and give their lives to Him like you have done.


But your message must always be: In Christ Alone! Look that hymn up in the bulletin; read the words with your mom and dad; pray about it.

Here are some things from my sermon about which you can talk to your mom and dad:

- 1. Do you pray for people who are lost and do not know Jesus? Do you have any nation or people-group you could pray for? Do you have any friends that you should be praying for them to become Christians?
- 2. Talk to your mom and dad about what it means to trust in Christ ALONE for your salvation. Salvation is not "Jesus + my good works." It is trusting in Him ALONE. This was part of the Jews' failure to understand that Jesus was the Messiah: they still wanted to keep the law to go to heaven. Why is that impossible? Rom. 3:23.
- 3. What are some of the riches Mr. Mac mentioned at the end of his sermon that Christians are given when they are saved? Mr. Mac also read Scriptures that talked about how God's kindness leads us to repentance. Discuss this with your mom and dad.
