





# Trinity Church Serving Jesus in Montgomery

Our Missions Ministry this week is about Montgomery and each one of us at Trinity Church. We gather on Sundays to worship God, but during the rest of the week, we are away from church in neighborhoods, schools, work places, restaurants, athletic fields and all the other places we go.

Whether you were born here or your family moved from another place, God put you in Montgomery. # Music and Hymns


### #283 "Allelujah, Allelujah"

The author, Christopher Wordsworth, a nephew of the 18th century English poet, William Wordsworth, was born in 1807 and educated at Cambridge University, receiving high honors for his academic accomplishments. He was known throughout England as an outstanding scholar, a tireless worker, and a voluminous writer. Among his writings is a collection of 127 hymns published in a hymnal (1862) called The Holy Year. These hymns were written by Wordsworth to illustrate his convictions that hymns should not deal with personal, individual interests, but rather should teach the truths of Scripture and voice the worship of the entire congregation. He also believed it was the first duty of the hymnwriter to teach sound doctrine to believers and to reach the unsaved with the gospel. This hymn is based on a verse from 1 Corinthians 15 which says "Christ has indeed been raised from the dead, the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep." In it, honor is given to Christ, who was the first to have victory over the grave and who will, at his second coming, give victory over death to all believers.

#### #277 "Christ the Lord Is Risen Today"

The grave has been "boasting" of its power since Eden. But now it has finally met its match. It wraps Jesus up at the Cross and "forbids Him rise," but our Champion, Jesus Christ, fought and won. Where is your sting now, O Death? Christ has won the final victory!
