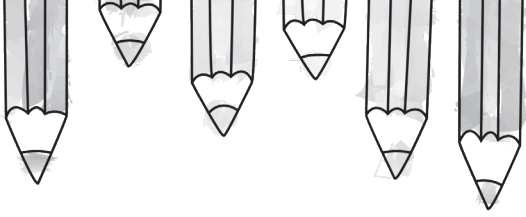

Just a word from Mrs. Stacy

Good morning children!

I hope that all of you enjoyed a wonderful Easter last Lord's Day!

This morning, Mr. Curles will preach from the New Testament book of Romans on the subject of faith. Do you know what "faith" is? Mr. Curles is going to preach about what true faith is, and what it is not.

In Romans 10:14-21, Paul has been teaching about salvation, especially the salvation of the Israelites, the Jewish people. The Israelites had rejected Jesus, the true Messiah. The Israelites looked religious, but they were trusting in who they were, Israelites, to save them. However, they were not saved because they had not received or believed in Jesus Christ.

In today's world, there is a lot of confusion about religion and spirituality. In this passage, Paul is teaching us what true saving faith is. True faith comes from hearing and reading the Word of God (the Bible) and by believing in Jesus Christ. It is important to go to church and read God's Word. Mr. Mac reminds us all the time that the Bible is "...God's mind in print" and that is inerrant (correct) and infallible (will not fail). As you grow up, you will see people who appear to be very spiritual, but their belief is not in Jesus Christ.

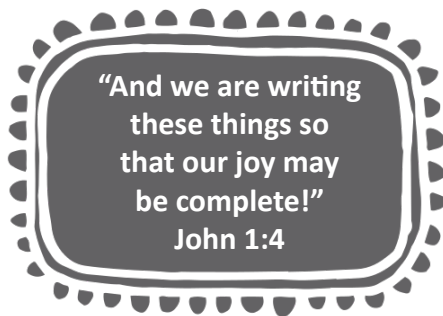

10 EASY STEPS

- #10** Dad, pray this over your children: Numbers 6:24–26
The LORD bless you and keep you; the LORD make His face to shine upon you and be gracious to you; the LORD lift up His countenance upon you and give you peace.



Greek Pastors in Athens

Trinity Church has a partnership with Greek Presbyterians from the First Greek Evangelical Church in Athens, Greece and the Greek Bible College in that same city. We sent teams of our people to work with them several times and several of them have visited Trinity including George Tolia who is one of their pastors that came to our Missions Conference this year. Pastor Giotis is the Senior Minister who pastors a church in the middle of the city. From that church, at least five more churches in other neighborhoods have been started. They also lead ministries with children who don't go to church and refugees from other countries who came to Greece seeking a better life. All the people who live in Greece are having a hard time because their economy has made everything very expensive to buy. The pastors asked us to pray for their church members and the people of Greece to know the Bible and follow Jesus as they start and grow more churches.

#32 "Great is Thy Faithfulness"

Our God is faithful! To be faithful means to be loyal, devoted, and unswerving. God is ALWAYS faithful to us. The chorus of this hymn says "all I have needed Thy hand hath provided--Great is Thy faithfulness, Lord unto me!"
