



God loves you so very much!! He saved you by His grace, NOT by something you did to deserve it. It was all His grace and mercy.

THE SIMPLEST OUTLINE FOR FAMILY TIME EVER!!! 10 EASY STEPS

#1	Just make sure you gather once a day as a family.

#4	Read a Bible verse. Maybe a devotional.
#5	Sing a song or two together.
#6	Take prayer requests.
#7	Pray. (Daddy, your children NEED to hear you pray.) Pray for the children; pray for missionaries; pray for Trinity Church; give thanks.
#8	Everyone tell one thing they are thankful for.
#9	Have a Leader of the Day: they get to read and/or pray and/or tell everyone to come gather and/or put out the Bibles/hymnals and/or tell something that happened to them that day.
#10	Dad, pray this over your children: Numbers 6:24–26



Greg & Julieann With Global Serve International

At first, Greg, Julieann, and their two sons lived in Siberia, Russia where the snow is deep and the winters are long and very cold. Then, they lived in other Asian countries to the South where it is warm and tropical. Over the years, Greg's job changed from just their own family's work to now when he supervises the work of many other people who live across the entire Asian region from very cold Siberia to very warm South Asia. Greg travels much of the time to supervise the work of these other people and recruit new workers. Their sons are in college now, and Greg and Julieann's home is in Florida even though Greg is not there very much. Julieann also travels with him some of the time.

Many of the countries where they work do not permit missionaries to enter. Greg helps people start businesses and schools that will permit his very talented workers to use their God-given abilities to help people earn an income while they also share about God's love and His desire for people from every tribe, language and nation to worship Him.
