


Will you pray for me? I would like nothing more than to know that you were praying for me as your pastor. I know God hears your prayers, and I would be honored if you would pray for me.



Here are some things from my sermon about which you can talk to your mom and dad:

- 1. What is pride? What is the opposite of pride?
- 2. Discuss with Mom and Dad: the kindness of God and the severity of God; His love and His wrath; His gentle kindness and His ruthless severity; His tenderness and His toughness. Mom and Dad, this is deep, but you can do it. Teach your children about Who God is. Think of ways during the sermon that you could convey this to your child. How could you take Mr. Mac's sermon and put it on a child's level?
- 3. Where can we see what God is like? In His Word and in creation. What does God's Word say about God? What does creation say about God? What is your favorite part of creation?
- 4. Do you know any Jewish people in your life? How can you pray for Jews? In what ways can you show them Jesus?
- 5. How do you make someone who is an unbeliever jealous for the things of Jesus?



Emanuel Ayala & Gabriela Guzman Students in the Isaiah 55 Deaf School In Reynosa, Mexico

Emanuel and Gabriela are students at the Isaiah 55 School for deaf children in Reynosa, Mexico. They receive a scholarship from Trinity Church so they can attend that school. It was started by NoNo and Kate Beale who are Trinity members and missionaries in Mexico.

Deaf children cannot hear the sounds most people hear, so they cannot communicate by talking. In their school, they learn sign language with their hands. Can you imagine not being able to talk with your parents or not being able to hear your parents say they love you? In addition to sign language, they learn to read and write and all the other things you learn at your school. They also learn about God, how Jesus died and was brought to life again to save them from their sins, and bring them into a new life for God.

Emanuel is fifteen and Gabriela is eleven years old. Emanuel's father is a blacksmith and his mother teaches at his school. His favorite foods are pizza, tacos and sandwiches and he likes to play video games. Gabriela's father works in a factory. Her favorite food is tacos and she likes jump rope. Will you write a letter to them? They would like to write back.

#164 "O For a Thousand Tongues to Sing"

This hymn is about praising our Lord for the many things He does for us, such as taking away our sins, sorrows, and fears. Charles Wesley wrote this hymn in the 1700's after a bout of illness made him doubt God. He began to read the Bible and the words gave him peace and his faith was restored. Charles wrote this hymn eleven years after his conversion and he recommended it as a hymn for others to sing on the anniversaries of their conversions. Have you ever thought of celebrating the anniversary of your salvation; the anniversary of giving your life to Christ? What song would you choose to praise Him on your conversion anniversary?

#111 "This Is My Father's World"
