


What do you love most about your mother? Well, you have seven days to think of a way to show her what you appreciate about her.

**THE SIMPLEST OUTLINE FOR FAMILY TIME EVER!!!
10 EASY STEPS**

- #1** Just make sure you gather once a day as a family.
- #2** Try really hard to make the same time every day.
- #3** It does not have to be long; it does not have to be perfect.
- #4** Read a Bible verse. Maybe a devotional.
- #5** Sing a song or two together.
- #6** Take prayer requests.
- #7** Pray. (Daddy, your children **NEED** to hear you pray.) Pray for the children; pray for missionaries; pray for Trinity Church; give thanks.
- #8** Everyone tell one thing they are thankful for.
- #9** Have a Leader of the Day: they get to read and/or pray and/or tell everyone to come gather and/or put out the Bibles/hymnals and/or tell something that happened to them that day.
- #10** Dad, pray this over your children: Numbers 6:24–26
The LORD bless you and keep you; the LORD make His face to shine upon you and be gracious to you; the LORD lift up His countenance upon you and give you peace.



**Meet Mark, Bridgette
and their five children**

**Serving with
Third Millennium
Ministries
In The Middle East**



Mark was raised in Birmingham, but has lived in the Middle East for over 20 years. His wife Bridgette was raised there in a Christian family. They have five children and live in her country. Mark teaches in a Christian seminary and travels to help Christians and churches. He also helps produce videos in Arabic for Third Millennium. Those videos train pastors and Bible teachers who can't go to a seminary.

Many of the countries in that region are beautiful, but they are not peaceful because groups of people are constantly fighting over religious, ethnic and political issues. This fighting goes all the way back to the time of Abraham in the Bible.

Their country was peaceful until recently when over a million refugees from another country came there fleeing for safety from a war. You may wonder why Mark's family stays there. They stay because that is their home and because God called them to serve Him and other people there by sharing the gospel.

#38 "Immortal, Invisible, God Only Wise"

As long as we are on the earth, God will be invisible to us. We cannot see Him, as He is hidden from our eyes, but He is visible to us in other ways in what things, places, or people on earth do you see God? List the ways we can see Him here on earth even though we cannot physically see Him:

#263 "Lift High the Cross"

Here we find a reminder that we are to hold the cross of Christ ever before our eyes as we await that time when all the world will "adore His sacred name."
