

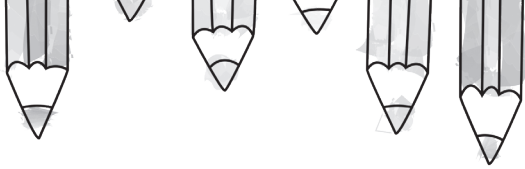

SEE WHO MY FRIEND IS IN WHAT I WROTE ABOVE

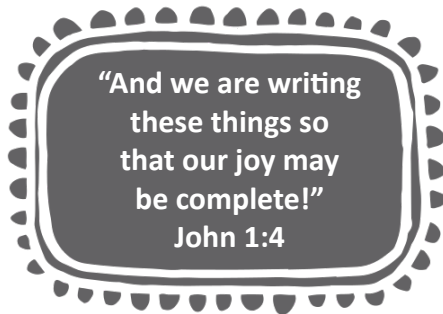

THE SIMPLEST OUTLINE FOR FAMILY TIME EVER!!!
10 EASY STEPS

- #1** Just make sure you gather once a day as a family.

The LORD bless you and keep you; the LORD make His face to shine upon you and be gracious to you; the LORD lift up His countenance upon you and give you peace.



Meet the Chinchin Family Jack & Nell Serving with African Bible Colleges

Where Do Our Missionaries Live and Work?

From pear growers in California to Gospel sowers in Africa - that's the life story of Jack and Nell Chinchin. They followed the call of God to Christian service. After pastoring Presbyterian churches, the Chinchins, with their seven children, responded to be missionaries in Africa. Seven years were spent in the jungles of Liberia before starting the African Bible Colleges in 1978. God has done more than they ever imagined with three campuses located in Liberia, Malawi, and Uganda.

The campus in Malawi also has a medical clinic that serves the surrounding community and ABC Christian Academy that offers a Christ-centered curriculum to 300 children from 19 countries. The ABC clinic is one of the finest medical facilities in the capitol city of Lilongwe.

The Chinchin ministry has become a family affair. Three of their seven children, along with their families, are missionaries serving with African Bible Colleges.

#457 "Come, Thou Fount"

This hymn talks about the way all believers stray from God at times in their life and how God is faithful to draw us back to Him. His mercy never ceases and He continues to invite us back into His arms when we wander away from Him. In fact, Jesus pursued us when we were yet sinners. Verse 2 says "Jesus sought me when a stranger, wand'ring from the fold of God: He, to rescue me from danger, interposed His precious blood." To interpose means to come between. Jesus has come between you and your sin by cleansing you through the blood He shed on the cross. Isn't that amazing? We did nothing to deserve it and even though we may try, we continue to do wrong, yet He continues to love us! What a wondrous blessing!

#469 "How Sweet and Awesome Is This Place"

Written by Isaac Watts, this one dates back to the year 1707. Read the story of the invited guests in Luke 14 to better understand this hymn.
