




#### Just a word from Mr. Mac Claude E. McRoberts III • Senior Minister

Dear Children,

Do not waste your life. (Think about that statement for a minute.)

That is a strong statement for a young person like yourself. Who in the world ever wants to waste their life? Well, I would hope no one. But people do.

Now, HOW do you think people could waste their life?

What I mean is: if you come to the end of your life and you look back, and you think, I wasted my life. HOW could someone do that?

Well, let me ask you – since you are a young person – what you might think about more: HOW can you waste a day? By sleeping all day. By doing nothing. By doing nothing but eating and watching TV or playing video games. When the end of the day comes, you'll look back, and you will say, Wow, I really wasted this day. I could have done so much more.

Well, that is what I mean!! People waste their lives when they do nothing for Jesus; when they do all they do for themselves; when they live for this world; when everything is about them; when they live a life of selfishness.

BUT! BUT a life that is not wasted is a life given to Jesus; a life that Jesus uses to His glory; a life, as Jesus said it, "seeking first His kingdom and His righteousness."

Here are some things from my sermon about which you can talk to your mom and dad:


1. What would a wasted life look like? Has your mom or dad ever known someone who wasted their lives?

The LORD bless you and keep you; the LORD make His face to shine upon you and be gracious to you; the LORD lift up His countenance upon you and give you peace.





Meet Charles and Carol DeWitt

Serving in Madrid, Spain With Mission to the World

## Where do our missionaries live and work?

Charles was raised in Nashville, Tennessee, and became a Christian in college. Carol was born and raised in Montgomery and attended Auburn University. Even though her family was active in a church when she was a child, she didn't know Jesus as her Lord and Savior until she was in college. After being married, they served as missionaries in Mexico for 12 years, and then Charles was the missions pastor of a church in Tennessee before they went to Spain in 2003.

Now they lead a church planting team in Madrid, Spain. Their goal is to train and mentor Spanish pastors to start and lead churches. They know that is the best way to start churches that will bring Spanish people to know Jesus. They have one church plant started in Madrid and are working with five other church plants in the suburbs and smaller cities. They have three adult sons and one daughter who live away from home.
