







# Bill and Cheryl Nikides Serving globally with The Presbyterian Evangelistic Fellowship

Bill is a native of New York City, a retired Air Force officer, a Gulf War veteran, a pastor and missionary. He answered the call to the ministry, following a shortterm mission trip to Uganda. Cheryl was raised in a Christian home in South Carolina. She came to know the Lord in church as a young girl of eight.

They served as missionaries in England, Belgium and Italy where they started or pastored churches for immigrants who came to Europe from Asia. Bill helped start a Presbyterian denomination in an Asian country and visits them at least once a year. Their most recent church was in Italy with American families from a nearby US Army base. Those Americans also welcomed Muslim immigrants and refugees. They returned to live in the United States this summer. Bill continues working with several missions agencies and many churches to help them better share the gospel of Jesus Christ with Muslims.

#### #575 "Soldiers of Christ, Arise"

We have to put on the armor of God every day in order to fight the battle against evil. What is the armor of God? Well, it can be found in Ephesians chapter 6. The armor of God is spiritual because "our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms."

The armor of God consists of the belt of truth, the breastplate of righteousness, the shield of faith, the helmet of salvation, the sword of the Spirit, and feet fitted with readiness.

#### #196 "Come Thou Long Expected Jesus"

This is a hymn about the joy and expectation of Jesus' birth and the joy and expectation of His second coming! Verse 4 says "Born thy people to deliver, born a child and yet a king, born to reign in us forever, now Thy gracious kingdom bring." Jesus' birth was prophesied hundreds of years before He was born. The Jews were anticipating a Messiah to be born of a virgin and that is exactly what happened. Now, 2000 years after His death, we await His second coming where we will get to see Him face to face. Isn't that exciting? Praise Him for his birth, praise Him for his death, praise Him for his resurrection, and praise Him that He is coming again!
