



Just a word from Mr. Curles

Dear Children,

When Jesus began His ministry, He did it in a very dramatic way. He went to church (the synagogue) one day and read a passage from Isaiah 61. It said:

"The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me, because the Lord has anointed me to bring good news to the poor; He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound." (Isaiah 61:1). He then closed the book and said, basically, "This passage is about Me."


Jesus came to set us free. All of us need to be set free. Not from a real prison... but from a prison of sin. Jesus died to set you and me free from sin and death so that we do not have to live under the power of sin anymore.

How does Jesus do this? The Bible tells us that the blood of Jesus makes us free (1 Peter 1:18-19). When we trust in Jesus with our hearts, His blood is what sets us free from sin. This happens in ways that we can't see, but that are still very real. It happens through the work of the Holy Spirit.

Each week we are going to learn more about the ways that Jesus sets us free. I want you to know that whatever situation you find yourself in, you can always ask Jesus to help you. He will do it!

THE SIMPLEST OUTLINE FOR FAMILY TIME EVER!!! 10 EASY STEPS



Meet Faith Radio Serving Montgomery and South Alabama

We walk by faith, not by sight. 2 Corinthians 5:7

This week's ministry is Faith Radio in Montgomery and six other locations in Alabama. Perhaps you have heard your parents listening to it or maybe you listen to *Paws & Tales* and *Adventures in Odyssey* that are on at 8:30 and 9:00 on Saturday mornings. Many of the programs include ministers and Bible teachers and Christian music. All of their programs are planned to encourage Christians and others who don't know Jesus to learn about Him.

Faith Radio is a "listener supported" station, which means they depend on donations from people who listen to the station instead of selling advertising like most stations do. The station broadcasts at 89.1 FM in Montgomery. Their call letters are WLBF, which stands for "We Live By Faith." Wiely Bowsell from Trinity Church is the Chief Engineer. He keeps all the electronic components functioning so the radio programs can be broadcast. Mr. John Albritton, Jr. is on the Board of Directors, which oversees all of the station activities.

Music and Hymns

#53 "Praise to the Lord, the Almighty"

This hymn is so encouraging! The Lord blesses us with so many things. He is our health and salvation, He shelters us, He grants our desires, He prospers our work, He defends us, He made us, He guides us, He gives us relief.

Thank Him with praise and adoration!

#164 "O For a Thousand Tongues to Sing"

This hymn is about praising our Lord for the many things He does for us, such as taking away our sins, sorrows, and fears. Charles Wesley wrote this hymn in the 1700's after a bout of illness made him doubt God. He began to read the Bible and the words gave him peace and his faith was restored. Charles wrote this hymn eleven years after his conversion and he recommended it as a hymn for others to sing on the anniversaries of their conversions. Have you ever thought of celebrating the anniversary of your salvation; the anniversary of giving your life to Christ? What song would you choose to praise Him on your conversion anniversary?
