




A Guide to Family Worship September 10-15, 2018

THE SIMPLEST OUTLINE FOR FAMILY TIME EVER!!! 10 EASY STEPS

#1 Just make sure you gather once a day as a family. Try really hard to make the same time every day. #2 It does not have to be long; it does not have to be perfect. #3 Read a Bible verse. Maybe a devotional. #4 Sing a song or two together. #5 #6 Take prayer requests. Pray. (Daddy, your children NEED to hear you pray.) Pray #7 for the children; pray for missionaries; pray for Trinity Church; give thanks. Everyone tell one thing they are thankful for. #8 Have a Leader of the Day: they get to read and/or pray and/ #9 or tell everyone to come gather and/or put out the Bibles/ hymnals and/or tell something that happened to them that day. #10 Dad, pray this over your children: Numbers 6:24-26 The LORD bless you and keep you; the LORD make His face to shine upon you and be gracious to you; the LORD lift up His countenance upon you and give you peace.



Family Promise in Montgomery

"Engaging people of faith to empower homeless families to return to stability"

This week's missions ministry serves families who don't have a place to live. It is called Family Promise. This ministry for homeless families happens right here in Trinity Church. The families who will stay in our Missions House this week cannot afford a house or apartment because the parents lost their job, or were sick or had to pay for very expensive car repairs. Trinity shares our facilities with 3 or 4 of these families for one week every three months to help them while they recover from a difficult situation. We serve them with supper and a safe place to sleep in Jesus' name because of the love He gives us. During the day, the parents look for a job or go to work if they have one while the children go to school or a community center. It usually takes about 4 months for a family to recover and get back into their own home.

Trinity Church does this with 14 other churches in Montgomery. Jayme Teague, who is a Trinity member, works for Family Promise and helps bring people into the program. Perhaps you have helped your parents provide meals or even stayed overnight in the church or the missions house when we hosted Family Promise. This is one of the easiest and most fun ministries we do because children can help their parents serve other people in Jesus' name.

Music and Hymns

#660 "O God Beyond All Praising"

This hymn really shows the true meaning of praise and worship. One large part of the praise and worship we do at church is singing. We lift up our voices to the Lord to praise and honor Him. This hymn also mentions that we marvel at His beauty, honor and adore Him, and triumph through our sorrows by offering praise through both the good and bad times. How do you praise Him?

#308 "Jesus Paid It All"

This hymn is about Jesus dying for our sins and paying for our sins even though we do not deserve it. The refrain proclaims "Jesus paid it all, all to Him I owe; sin had left a crimson stain, He washed it white as snow." We are dirty and covered in sin, but God sees us as clean and holy because Jesus has cleansed us. Verse 3 says "I'll wash my garments white in the blood of Calv'ry's Lamb." Jesus was the final Passover lamb, the ultimate sacrifice. You are never too sinful for Jesus. No matter what you have done, He has the power to cleanse you and make you cleanin the sight of God the Father.
