



Good morning children!!

THE SIMPLEST OUTLINE FOR FAMILY TIME EVER!!! 10 EASY STEPS

#1 Just make sure you gather once a day as a family. Try really hard to make the same time every day. #2 #3 It does not have to be long; it does not have to be perfect. Read a Bible verse. Maybe a devotional. #4 #5 Sing a song or two together. #6 Take prayer requests. Pray. (Daddy, your children NEED to hear you pray.) Pray #7 for the children; pray for missionaries; pray for Trinity Church: give thanks. Everyone tell one thing they are thankful for. #8 Have a Leader of the Day: they get to read and/or pray and/ #9 or tell everyone to come gather and/or put out the Bibles/ hymnals and/or tell something that happened to them that day. #10 Dad, pray this over your children: Numbers 6:24–26 The LORD bless you and keep you; the LORD make His face to shine upon you and be gracious to you; the LORD lift up His countenance upon you and give you

peace.



Victor & Nosizo Nakah Serving in Africa with Mission to the World

Victor and Nosizo were born in Zimbabwe which is a country on the southeastern coast of the continent of Africa. They became Christians and were discipled in high school and college, which is where they met each other. After getting married they led a ministry to other college students.

Victor became a Presbyterian minister and pastored churches and helped to lead other ministries that stretched out across Africa. He also taught at a university and then served as president of a seminary in their country. He has been well known to many of the missionaries from our denomination because of his strong commitment to serve Jesus as a pastor and ministry leader. Last year, the Mission to the World leaders asked him to become the International Director for Sub-Saharan Africa. In that role, he supervises many missionaries across the continent and coordinates their work with African pastors and churches. Victor will worship with us this Sunday.

#263 "Lift High the Cross"

Here we find a reminder that we are to hold the cross of Christ ever before our eyes as we await that time when all the world will "adore His sacred name." #264 "Jesus, Keep Me Near the Cross"

If you keep the cross in the forefront of your mind, you will not focus so much on the negative things in your life. When you lay your cares at the foot of the cross, you can let them go and trust that Jesus will take care of them! So, stay near to the cross. Stay near to the one Who died for you, Who chose you, and Who loves you!
