




Images of:


- an untouched but beautifully decorated birthday cake?

THE SIMPLEST OUTLINE FOR FAMILY TIME EVER!!! 10 EASY STEPS

#1 Just make sure you gather once a day as a family. Try really hard to make the same time every day. #2 #3 It does not have to be long; it does not have to be perfect. Read a Bible verse. Maybe a devotional. #4 #5 Sing a song or two together. #6 Take prayer requests. Pray. (Daddy, your children NEED to hear you pray.) Pray #7 for the children; pray for missionaries; pray for Trinity Church: give thanks. Everyone tell one thing they are thankful for. #8 Have a Leader of the Day: they get to read and/or pray and/ #9 or tell everyone to come gather and/or put out the Bibles/ hymnals and/or tell something that happened to them that day. #10 Dad, pray this over your children: Numbers 6:24–26 The LORD bless you and keep you; the LORD make His face to shine upon you and be gracious to you; the LORD lift up His countenance upon you and give you

peace.



When Bryan was a teenager, he played sports with boys from a low-income neighborhood. Many of those kids felt there was no hope for a good future. Many turned to stealing, drugs and other illegal activities. From that experience, Bryan wants to help kids find hope by putting their trust in Jesus and then learn to do what God wants each of us to do with our lives.

After seminary, Bryan and his wife Delta felt God's call to the Washington Park neighborhood in West Montgomery. He started the Common Ground Montgomery ministry in 2007. First, he coached baseball and football at Carver High School and got involved in kids' lives. Today, with the help of other staff and volunteers, they tutor over 100 kids every day after school and also have a great summer program. They do tutoring for school work, creative activities, recreation, and Bible studies to help the kids know God, and glorify Him with their lives.

#343 "Christ Is Made the Sure Foundation"

Isaiah prophesied about Jesus being a "cornerstone for a sure foundation" hundreds of years before Jesus was born. Psalm 118: 22, also written long before Jesus was born, says, "The stone that the builders rejected has become the cornerstone." This is accurate because Jesus was rejected by His own people, the Jews, while He was on earth. Jesus actually quotes Psalm 118:22 in Matthew 21:42 while He was still alive on earth. Isn't that amazing how we can see prophecies about Jesus in the Old Testament.

#520 "Jesus, Thy Blood and Righteousness"

We are clothed in righteousness in the sight of God through the blood of Jesus that was shed on the cross! He is also preparing a place for us in heaven! In John 14:2 Jesus says, "In My Father's house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you." Verse 3 of this hymn proclaims "when from the dust of death I rise to claim my mansion in the skies, ev'n then this shall be all my plea, Jesus hath lived, hath died, for me."
