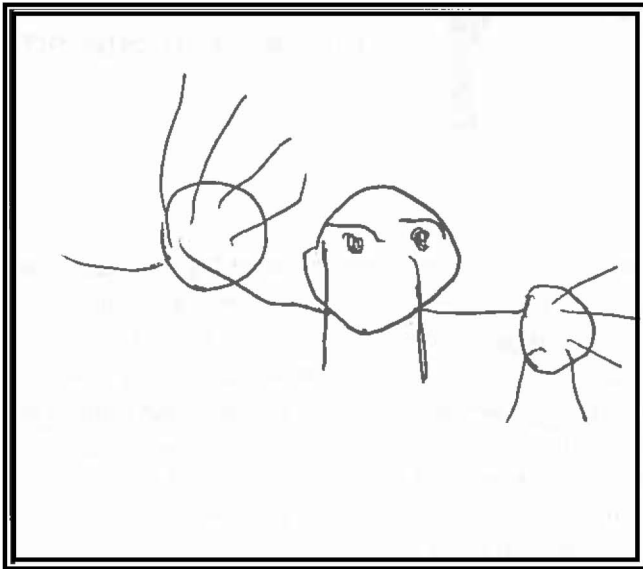


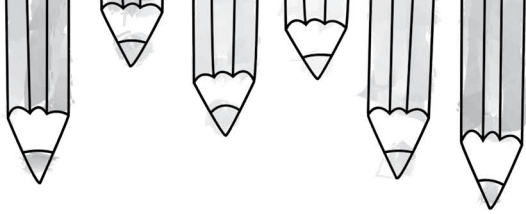

Good morning children!

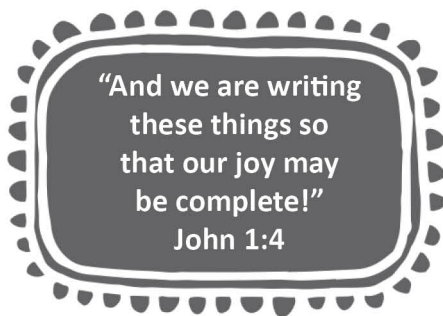
This morning Mr. Curles will be preaching about freedom from lies. Have you ever considered how you might be held captive to a lie? My letter to you last week talked about what happens to us when WE tell a lie, but what happens when we believe a lie, particularly one from Satan?

Satan is often referred to as "the father of lies." In fact, in John 8:34, that is exactly what he is called and that verse even says that "...there is no truth in him." Now, let's go back to my original question: how can you be held captive to a lie? Boys and girls, there are many ways. Have you ever felt like you weren't good enough, or you weren't smart enough, or if only I was taller? On the other hand, have you ever felt like you were better than someone else, or you bragged about a particular skill that you had? These are all lies from Satan!!

Scripture tells us that we are created in God's own image; therefore, we are already good enough, we are enough. Enough, in fact, that Jesus sent his Son, truly the only perfect being, to die for us in order that we may live eternally with Jesus! Boys and girls, the only way to combat these lies is with TRUTH!! That is, reading and knowing the Word of God. Reading and studying your Bible is so very important! Matthew 4:4 tells us that "Man shall not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God." I hope that if you haven't already, that you will make daily study of God's Word a habit.

The LORD bless you and keep you; the LORD make His face to shine upon you and be gracious to you; the LORD lift up His countenance upon you and give you peace.


