




Good morning boys and girls!


How many of you know the Ten Commandments perfectly? Have you ever tried to keep all ten of the commandments perfectly? Were you successful at keeping all Ten Commandments perfectly?

When I was a little girl, I would try to keep all the commandments perfectly, but it didn't take me very long to break one, usually just a few minutes! Questions 103 and 104 of the Children's Catechism are very helpful in understanding the Ten Commandments. Question 103 asks: "Can any man keep these ten commandments perfectly?" The answer is: "No mere man, since the fall of Adam, ever did or can keep the ten commandments perfectly." Boys and girls, the only person who fulfilled the Ten Commandments perfectly was Jesus. We are sinful human beings and simply aren't capable of keeping all of the commandments perfectly.

Question 104 asks: "Of what use are the ten commandments to us?" This is a very important question because if we know we're not capable of keeping them, then why do we need them? The answer is: "They teach us our duty, and show our need of a Savior." Any righteousness that we have is thru Jesus and his death on the cross. We can't possibly be "good" enough to earn our way into Heaven. Jesus died to pay the penalty for our sins because we couldn't do it for ourselves. I hope you're memorizing your Children's Catechism. It is the best way to understand the basic foundations of the Bible. We always have plenty of copies (the little purple books) here at the church and I'm happy to give you one so you can learn it!

Make plans to join us for the Reformation Party this coming Wednesday, October 31st, from 5-6 pm here at the church. We'll have pony rides, hot dogs, popcorn, new games, and fun bluegrass music to enjoy!



Meet Our Missionaries!



NoNo & Kate Beale Serving in Reynosa, Mexico with Isaiah 55

The Beales are members of Trinity Presbyterian Church, but they serve in Mexico where NoNo is the Director of Isaiah 55. Their ministry is in Reynosa, which is a Mexican city on the border with Texas.

This ministry began with a school for deaf children because there is not a place for them to learn in that city. There are over 60 children in the school now. While teaching deaf children to read and communicate with sign language is important, the primary goal of the school is to share the gospel with the students and their families.

The school is doing so well that NoNo expanded the ministry to a very poor neighborhood where there are many problems. New missionary staff have come to help. People from a church also volunteer. They offer after school tutoring and recreation for children and teens. They also teach art and music classes and help adults learn how to get better jobs so they can support their families. They started Bible studies and hope to start a church for the people in that neighborhood.

92 "A Mighty Fortress is Our God"

God is indeed a mighty fortress! Do you know what a fortress is? A fortress is a safe place that protects those who are inside.

You can imagine a castle with high walls and a mote surrounding it with guards and cannons ready to defend it at the first sign of an enemy. God is our fortress. Psalm 18:2 says "The Lord is my rock and my fortress and my deliverer, my God, my rock, in whom I take refuge, my shield, and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold." #378 "Here, O My Lord, I see Thee Face to Face"

This is a perfect hymn for communion. Most of you have probably not ever taken communion, but I am sure you have seen it and heard about it. We eat bread and drink grape juice that symbolize Jesus' body and blood shed on the cross for our sins. Taking communion is a very intimate moment with Jesus. Verse 4 says "Mine is the sin, but Thine the righteousness; mine is the guilt, but Thine the cleansing blood." Communion is a reminder that Christ died for our sins and we do it in remembrance of Him!
