



Good morning children!

This morning, Mr. Howell will preach from Psalms 8. Remember, "Psalms" means "book of praises" and Psalms 8 is a perfect example of praise. Psalms 8 was written by David and is a reflection of the glory and majesty of God. In fact, Psalms 8 begins and ends with the same declaration: "O LORD, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth!" David wants to honor the excellency of God's name. THE SIMPLEST OUTLINE FOR FAMILY TIME EVER!!! 10 EASY STEPS

#1 Just make sure you gather once a day as a family. Try really hard to make the same time every day. #2 #3 It does not have to be long; it does not have to be perfect. #4 Read a Bible verse. Maybe a devotional. #5 Sing a song or two together. Take prayer requests. #6 #7 Pray. (Daddy, your children NEED to hear you pray.) Pray for the children; pray for missionaries; pray for Trinity Church; give thanks. Everyone tell one thing they are thankful for. #8 #9 Have a Leader of the Day: they get to read and/or pray and/ or tell everyone to come gather and/or put out the Bibles/ hymnals and/or tell something that happened to them that day. #10 Dad, pray this over your children: Numbers 6:24-26 The LORD bless you and keep you; the LORD make His face to shine upon you and be gracious to you; the LORD lift up His countenance upon you and give you peace.





Could you be a missionary?

A missionary goes to another country or culture and tells people about Jesus. Jesus told His disciples in Matthew 28:18-20 to go into all the world and make disciples. That applies to us, too. Some missionaries are ministers. Others are doctors, nurses, teachers or business people or they do many other jobs, but they all tell people about Jesus and help start churches so people can worship God.

Over the years, many people and families from Trinity became missionaries and live in other countries. The Illman family became missionaries 8 years ago and moved to England. Two of their children were born there. Some people decide to become a missionary when they are children. Other people realize that God is calling them to become a missionary after they become adults.

Even though you aren't a missionary now, you can learn to tell other people around you at school and in your neighborhood about God. Maybe someday, God will call you to become a missionary, but He always wants us to tell others about Him.

This hymn tells the story of the wise men who followed the Christmas star to bring gifts and praise to Jesus Christ, King of the Jews. They left their homes and their country to find Jesus.

Verse 5 says "In the heav'nly country bright need they no created light; thou its light, its joy, its crown, thou its sun which goes not down; there forever may we sing alleluias to our King."
