

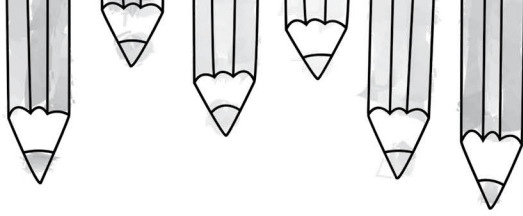

Just a word from Mr. Mac

Dear Children,

The Apostle Paul said: **But that matters little. What matters most to me is to finish what God started: the job the Master Jesus gave me of letting everyone I meet know all about this incredibly extravagant generosity of God.** Acts 20:24 (The Message)

I know you are young, but have you ever thought about what matters the very most to you in this life? Think about it ...

Think about missionaries who have gone out from their lives here in America to places of great danger.

Think about Christians who live in danger every day. Some of our brothers and sisters love Jesus so much, but they are hated by others who do not love Jesus. They have to worship Jesus in secret. They have to sing quietly so that the police do not hear them. If they do, they will be taken to jail.

Think about martyrs – these are ones who have given their lives for Jesus. There are millions and millions of them over thousands of years. They are in heaven today asking God, *How long before Jesus comes back?!* These people loved Jesus more than life.

You are not too young to say, *I love Jesus more than anything else in all the world.* And I hope you do. I hope He is your best Friend. I hope you talk to Him (pray). I hope you know you can trust Him. And that He loves you. And that He is going to take care of you all the time no matter what!

Paul knew he was headed to some very hard times and most likely prison. But he was more committed to doing what Jesus had called him to do than he was to his own happiness, safety and well-being. We need to ask God to make Christians like that!

Suggested Questions for Mom and Dad to Use This Week

1. Depending on the age of your child, somehow at their level, begin talking to them about what it means to love Jesus more than anyone or anything. Speak to them about people who have sacrificed so much. Speak to them about their willingness to sacrifice for Jesus. Ask them if they might think about being a missionary one day. Tell them about how we are all missionaries at school, at work, at play.
2. This would be a good week to explain to your children about faith and repentance. Such talks will go well with Mr. Mac's sermon.
3. Again, age-appropriate stories of missionaries (even those who gave their lives) would be wonderful this week leading up to the missions conference next week.
4. Pray with your children giving thanks for Trinity Church where they know they will hear the truth in love; where the ministers do not hold back on preaching all the Bible says about God. It's rare, and our children should know this, and give thanks to God.

**THE SIMPLEST OUTLINE FOR FAMILY TIME EVER!!!
10 EASY STEPS**

- #1** Just make sure you gather once a day as a family.

- #9** Have a Leader of the Day: they get to read and/or pray and/or tell everyone to come gather and/or put out the Bibles/hymnals and/or tell something that happened to them that day.
- #10** Dad, pray this over your children: Numbers 6:24–26
The LORD bless you and keep you; the LORD make His face to shine upon you and be gracious to you; the LORD lift up His countenance upon you and give you peace.


