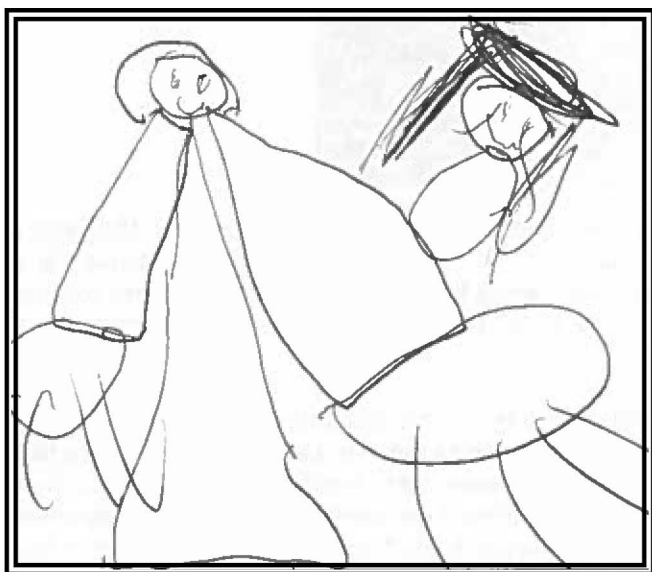


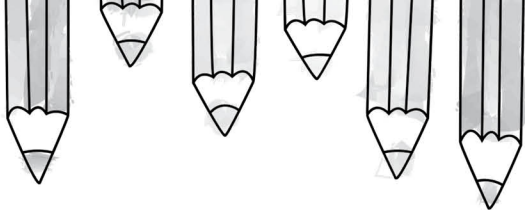

THE SIMPLEST OUTLINE FOR FAMILY TIME EVER!!!
10 EASY STEPS

- #1** Just make sure you gather once a day as a family.

- #6** Take prayer requests.

- #8** Everyone tell one thing they are thankful for.
- #9** Have a Leader of the Day: they get to read and/or pray and/or tell everyone to come gather and/or put out the Bibles/hymnals and/or tell something that happened to them that day.
- #10** Dad, pray this over your children: Numbers 6:24–26



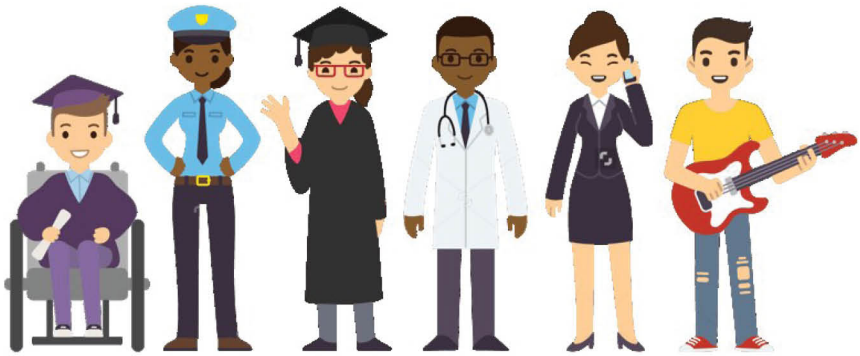

Meet Our Missionaries!



A missionary is someone who is sent by a church to another country or culture to tell people about Jesus. He told His disciples in Matthew 28:18-20 to go into all the world and make disciples. That applies to us, too.

Some missionaries are ministers because we want to start churches where people become new Christians and learn to make more disciples. Other missionaries are doctors and nurses to help people who are sick. Others are teachers to help people learn to read the Bible and have a job.

There are many other jobs that missionaries can do as part of a team of people who will start a church, clinic or school. They can be business managers, accountants, lawyers or many other jobs where they are even paid by the business for which they work, but they tell people about Jesus and help start churches so people can worship God.

Even though you aren't a missionary now, you can learn to tell other people about God. He always wants us to do that. Perhaps someday, God will call you to be a missionary.

Will you ask God to help more people at Trinity to become missionaries?
