

You probably know that the final week of His earthly life started on Palm Sunday with the Triumphal Entry; He would die on the cross on Friday; and, He would be resurrected to life on Sunday. But do you know what happened during the rest of the week? A LOT happened!!

On Tuesday of that week, He woke up in the town of Bethany where He had been staying overnight at His good friends' home. He walked back to Jerusalem, to the temple. And there he interacts with all kinds of people. He tells some stories to teach the people about His Father, and about Himself, and about them.

Even though people were trying to trap Him, Jesus kept on loving people. Sometimes that meant saying hard things to them.



THE SIMPLEST OUTLINE FOR FAMILY TIME EVER!!! 10 EASY STEPS

#1 Just make sure you gather once a day as a family. Try really hard to make the same time every day. #2 It does not have to be long; it does not have to be perfect. #3 Read a Bible verse. Maybe a devotional. #4 Sing a song or two together. #5 #6 Take prayer requests. Pray. (Daddy, your children NEED to hear you pray.) Pray #7 for the children; pray for missionaries; pray for Trinity Church; give thanks. Everyone tell one thing they are thankful for. #8 Have a Leader of the Day: they get to read and/or pray and/ #9 or tell everyone to come gather and/or put out the Bibles/ hymnals and/or tell something that happened to them that day. #10 Dad, pray this over your children: Numbers 6:24-26 The LORD bless you and keep you; the LORD make His face to shine upon you and be gracious to you; the LORD lift up His countenance upon you and give you peace.





Meet Our Missionaries!



Ken Austin
Serving
West Montgomery
through
Mercy House

Mercy House is a ministry in West Montgomery that provides food and other help for poor people in that neighborhood while also doing evangelism and discipleship. It is led by Pastor Ken Austin who also serves as the minister at New Walk of Life Church located across the street from Mercy House.

When Pastor Austin worked with Bryan Kelly at Common Ground Montgomery, he realized how many children there didn't have supper when they went home because their parents didn't have enough money to provide for their families. He thought about what Jesus told his followers in Matthew 25 about giving food and other help to people in need, so Pastor Austin started Mercy House in 2010 to do that. Now, they provide food for families to fix at home, after school snacks and homework help for students, and help homeless people with hot meals, showers and a place to wash and dry their clothes.
